  - that 80,000 refugees, Jewish and Non-Jewish, now in neutral countries be removed to French North Africa, Cyrenica, Lybia and Abyssinia
  - that an inter-governmental committee be set up to feed and care for refugees in neutral countries.
- This pamphlet criticises the lack of concrete measures outlined in Bermuda and desperately urges immediate action in the face of the continued destruction of European Jewry. **£40**
