The index tabulates the collection:- Diamonds, Rubies & Diamonds, Emeralds & Daimonds, Sapphires and Diamonds, Pink Pearls and Diamonds, Turquoises & Diamonds, Catseyes & Diamonds, Rings, Sundries, Brooches, Bracelets, Necklaces, Chains & Pins, Watches. Clearly items were altered as fashion changed and Garrard inventory is marked in red ink to reflect this for example 'Used in small bar Brooch', 'Used for centres of Collar' 'Broken Up'

Cloth backstrip, paper covered boards, 33cm, 64 + (2)pp. In custom made gilt cloth box. Some splitting at spine, some staining and tearing, no loss of text, a few repairs. Text in Hebrew with Italian translation. It was produced simultaneously in two versions one just in Hebrew and one in Hebrew with an Italian translation this one has the Italian translation.

'The Trieste Haggadah is undoubtedly the most distinguished illustrated edition produced in Europe during the nineteenth century.

As the engraved Gothic title page already indicates, the Haggadah is different in format and design from any that preceded it. Almost every page contains a large engraving above the text, drawn by C. Kirchmeyer. Though inspired by the iconographic themes of the past, the Trieste engravings display a welcome freshness of design. This edition has the Hebrew text with an Italian translation and also has the music of Adir Hu.' (See Yerusalmi - The Haggadah in History.) Many engravings. Yudlov 1217

This Haggadah marked an important stage of Haggadah design "Among its visual highlights were a magnificent architectural border surrounding every page of text., woodcut initials enclosing miniature figures and scenes, and the large woodcut initials enclosing miniature figures and scenes, and large woodcut illustrations placed at the top or bottom of almost every page. Not only are these new, but they are arranged in a meaningful biblical cycle that begins with Abraham and later focuses on the narratives actually recalled in the text of the Haggadah. two illustrated pages were novel in every respect" These are the multiframe illustrations of the Seder service and the Ten Plagues. 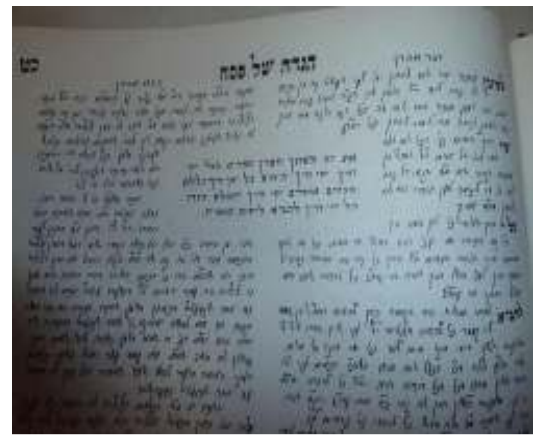

A Haggadah produced from an extraordinary manuscript by the Chassidic Rebbe, Rav Abraham Aharon Friedman from Chop (Ukraine), a descendant of Belz and Satmar Hasidim and student of Rabbi Yosef Tzevi Duchinsky (Maharits: 1865-1948) a grandson of Hatam Sofer. He died during the Holocaust in a labour camp in 1942. The manuscript of the Haggadah with his commentary was preserved by his daughter and after the war taken by Belz Hasidim to the Land of Israel. A facsimile of the manuscript was first published in Brooklyn in 1974 with haskamah of the Sigbet rabbi, Moshe Teitelbaum (future Satmar rabbi). A second facsimile edition was published by the author's son-in-law, Yeshaya Friedman, in Jerusalem in 1976, with haskamot of the Belz and Dushinsky rebbes. Because of the rivalry of the two different Chassidic sects, they published the same manuscript in two different versions but finally came together in a new, re-edited and re-published edition of the manuscript in 2002 in Jerusalem. In the first 2 versions the original manuscript has been reproduced in facsimile and you can see the Rebbe's cursive script. It is an extraordinary manuscript where he has separated each of his different commentaries into a different text block running simultaneously through the Haggadah surrounding the text of the Haggadah. Even with typesetting this would be complex but in a hand written manuscript this is quite remarkable. In the final version the manuscript has been transcribed and printed in both a square and Rashi Hebrew scripts.

Copenhagen Bureau 1915-1918

The Zionist Bureau in Copenhagen became a clearinghouse for Zionist affairs during World War 1. The outbreak of the War confronted the World Zionist Organisation with a threat to its unity. Neutrality towards the belligerents was the only possible attitude to adopt for any international

Jewish Organization. The head office of the WZO was in Berlin and they were looking to move it to NY or the Hague. However, with entrance of the Ottoman Empire into the war, and out of concern for the Palestine Jewry, they decided to keep the head office in Berlin. This would help influence the German government on behalf of Palestine Jewry. The Copenhagen Bureau published a couple of books and pamphlets, and issued the Copenhagen Manifesto in October 1918. It also published a bimonthly *Bulletin*. Below are 5 issues of this *Bulletin*.
