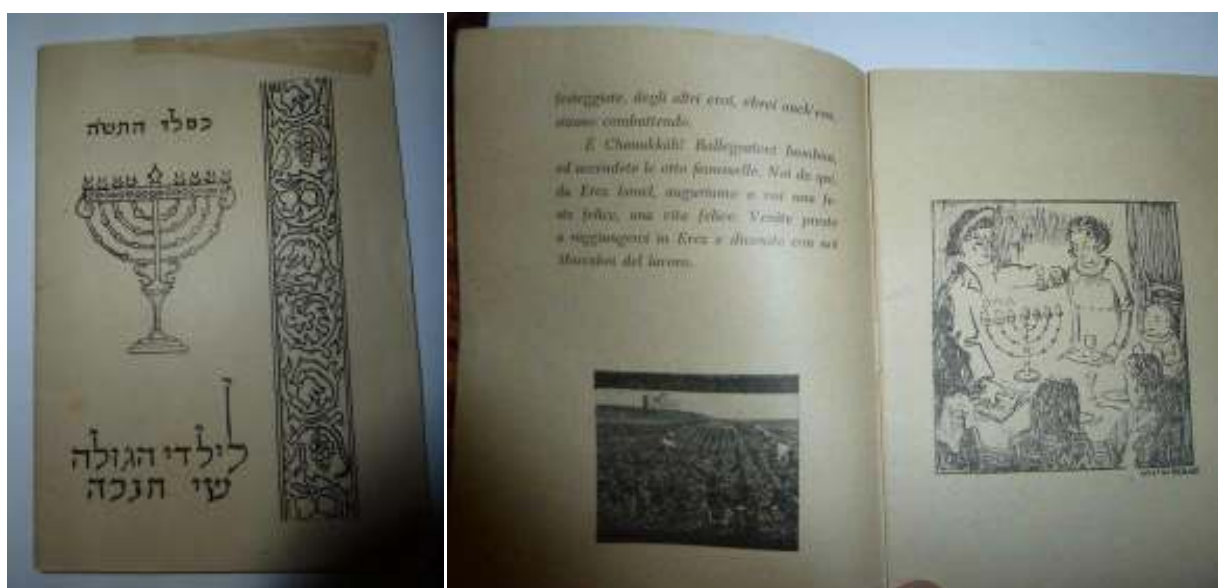

1. **Late 19th Century Brass Chanukah Lamp.** c 19th Century [13775]

A Late 19th Century brass Eastern European Chanukah Lamp probably made in Warsaw. With embossed and chased back plate depicting two lions flanking a Menorah. 23cm high. **£475**



2. **L'Yaldei HaGolah Shai Chanukah** [To the children of the Diaspora a gift for Chanukah]. Italy 1945 [13806]

Original wrappers. 15cm. 31 pp illus. Text in Italian, Hatikva and Birkat Ha'am in Hebrew. The back cover has a map of Erez -Israel. The top edge of the front wrapper is cut down a bit and there is a piece of tape over it, otherwise very good condition. No imprint or place of printing. Presumably this was is an item of Sbearet HaPletah (produced for the survivors).

3. **Dore (illustrator). Small Hebrew Bible Illustrated by Gustave Dore.** Paris, Distributed by Central in Warsaw 1913 [4448]

2 volume, leatherbound, gilt edged attractive Hebrew Bible, 12cm, 1384 pp with illustrations by Gustave Dore. Both volumes have the blind stamp and symbol of "the Central Publishers Warsaw" on the rear boards. Spines are a little sunned but an attractive copy. Text entirely in Hebrew.

12 cm, high. One side has a map, the other says Keren Kayemeth Leisrael (Jewish National Fund), Jerusalem, Made in Erez Israel (Palestine). A little soiling to the map and spotting to top, overall very good condition.

Wrappers 19cm, French 68 pp + Hebrew 36 pp. The wrappers are detached, a little bit of damp staining to outer margins, overall still a reasonably good copy. Dedicated to Albert Cohn a dedicated Jewish Chess and book dealer and collector. Hollaenderski reproduces a medieval Hebrew classic and translates it with some additional material.
