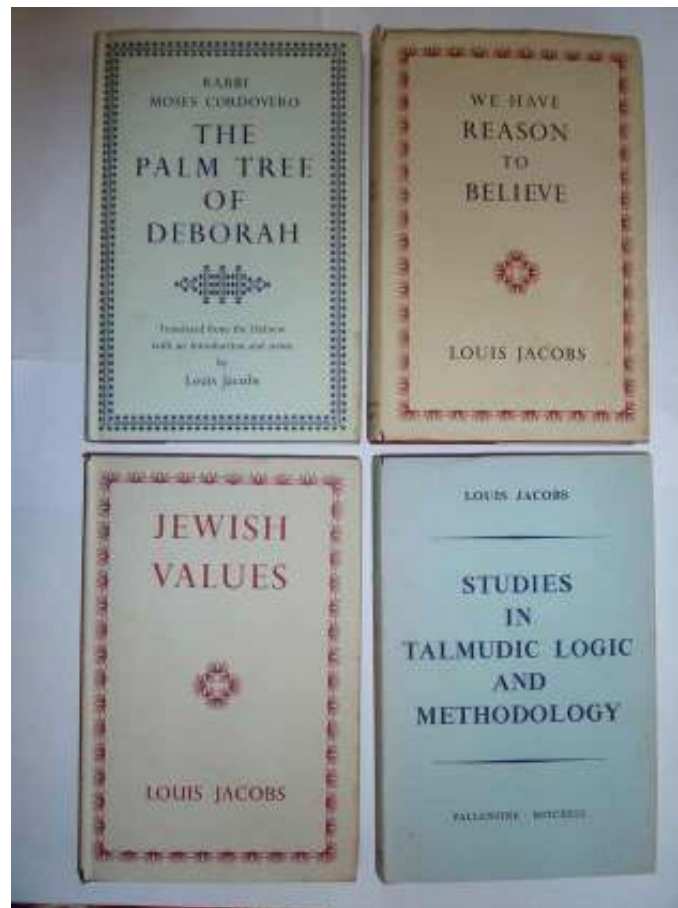

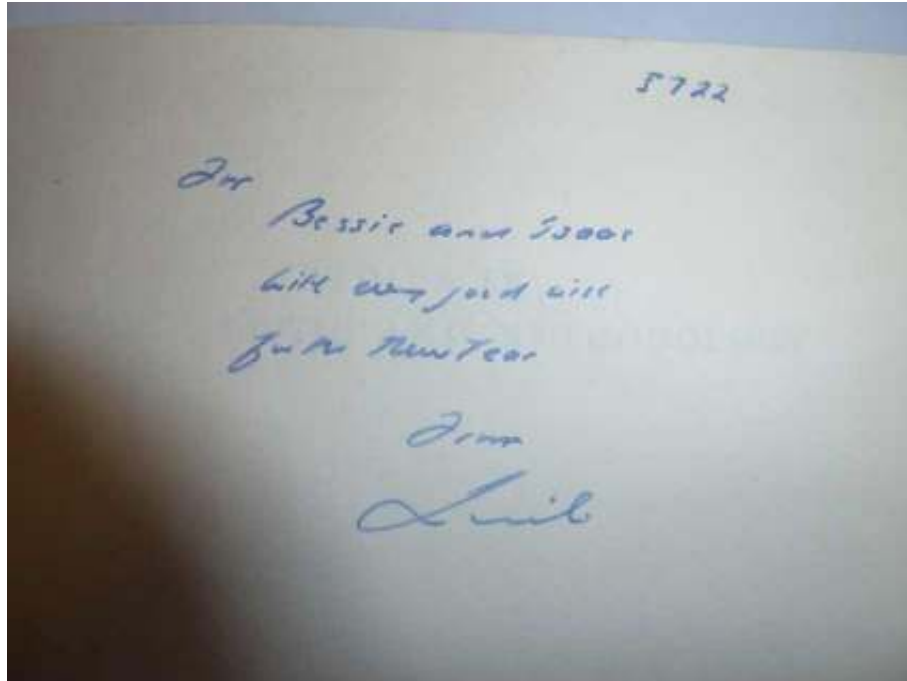


#### Four books by Rabbi Louis Jacobs all Signed First Editions

Rabbi Louis Jacobs, born in Manchester in 1920, became one of the most prominent English rabbis of the second half of the 20<sup>th</sup> Century. He initially intended to study at the famed Telz Yeshiva, but the deteriorating situation in Eastern Europe prevented this, and instead he went to Gateshead Yeshiva, and later to University College London. He was a pulpit rabbi and authored about 60 books on Judaism across a vast array of subjects. His most notable areas of expertise were theology, Chassidism, Kabbalah and Talmud. He was the unwilling participant in one of Anglo Jewry's most notable controversies – known as the 'Jacobs Affair' see below. He died in 2006.

### 'The Jacobs Affair'

In 1959, Rabbi Louis Jacobs was appointed as a tutor at Jews' College in London. It was expected that upon the retirement of Rabbi Epstein in 1961, Rabbi Jacobs would be appointed the Principal, and that this would eventually lead to him becoming the Chief Rabbi of the UK. However, Chief Rabbi Brodie refused to appoint him as Principal on the basis that the views expressed in his book *We Have Reason to Believe* [see item 1] were considered unorthodox. Rabbi Jacobs then resigned from his position at Jews' College in protest. There was a second stage to the 'Affair' when in 1964, Rabbi Jacobs' previous position as the Rabbi of the New West End Synagogue became available. Chief Rabbi Brodie blocked Rabbi Jacobs' re-appointment – consequently, about half the membership established an independent synagogue called the New London Synagogue under the leadership of Rabbi Jacobs. This was the catalyst for the development of the Masorti Movement in the UK.

## Some interesting items of Hebraica

### Daf Yomi in the DP camps (The Daily Page of Talmud Studied in the Displaced Person (DP) Camps in the aftermath of WW2.

In the chaotic aftermath of WW2 and the Holocaust, there were hundreds of thousands of Jewish survivors stranded in Eastern Europe, mostly waiting to go to Palestine. They needed books, newspapers, religious texts, school text books and these were produced by organizations within the camps or by organizations in America or Palestine. This volume is a Talmud for use in the DP camps and has a Daf Yomi calendar at the beginning so that individuals can co-ordinate their Talmud learning with others around the world.

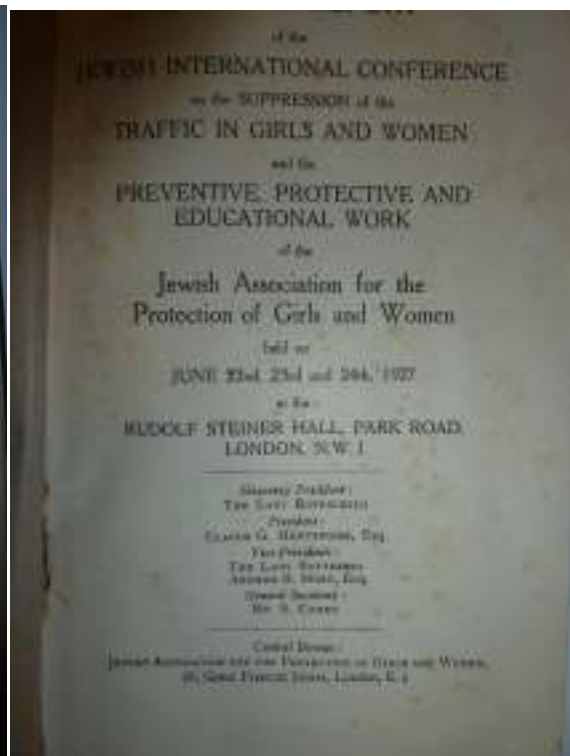
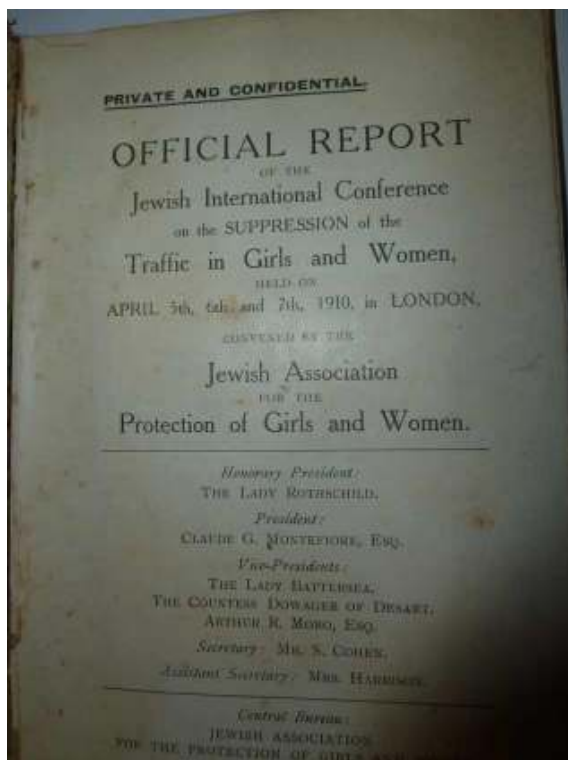

### White Slavery and the Jewish Community

White slavery and the traffic in women and girls was a severe problem for the Jewish communities in the main centres of immigration such as London and New York during the last decades of the 19<sup>th</sup> century and first decades of 20<sup>th</sup> Century. Women who were married in Eastern Europe followed their bridegrooms to London, only to find they were embroiled in the 'white slave traffic'. It raised many issues such as the 'Stille Chupah' whereby women were married to a man in Poland who promised them a good life in a big city only to entrap them into white slavery and they were abducted when they arrived in London. The same man may have married several women in different cities and enticed them to London and New York. A major part of the problem is that they were married under Jewish Law but not under civil law and so had not protection by the State. The problem became so extensive that communal figures organized conferences to address the problem. The Rabbis were very active and supportive, notably Chief Rabbis, Herman Adler and Joseph Hertz, also Moses Gaster, Moses Hyamson and Meir Hildersheimer amongst others. There were several prominent women including Lady Rothschild, Lady Battersea and Bertha Pappenheim who attended the conference. It was also used against the Jewish community by anti-semites who focused on it in their anti-Jewish propaganda.
