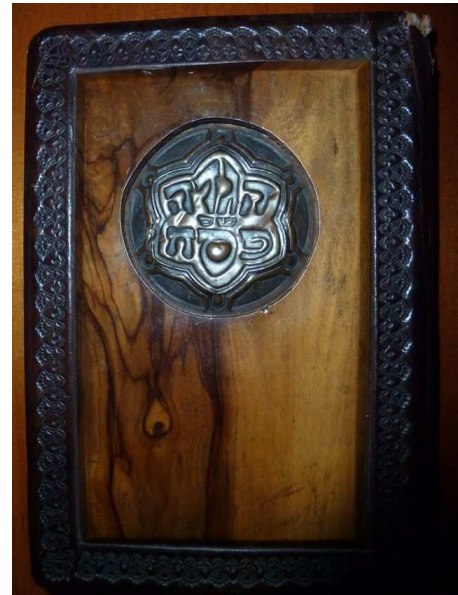

The illustrations are by Nachum Guttman (1898 – 1980) who was one of the Bezalel artists and one of the most important artists of the Yishuv and the early State of Israel who helped pioneer a distinctively Israeli style. 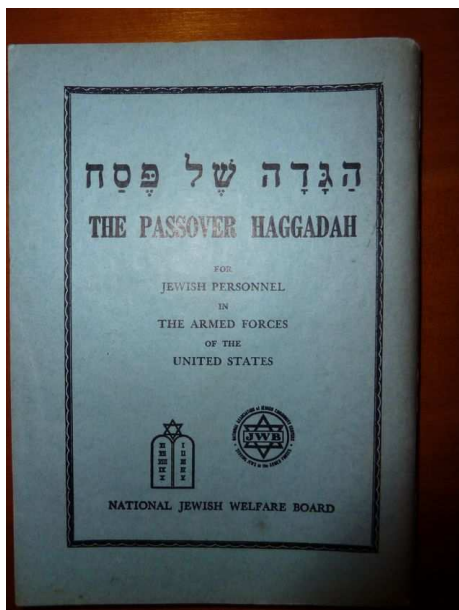

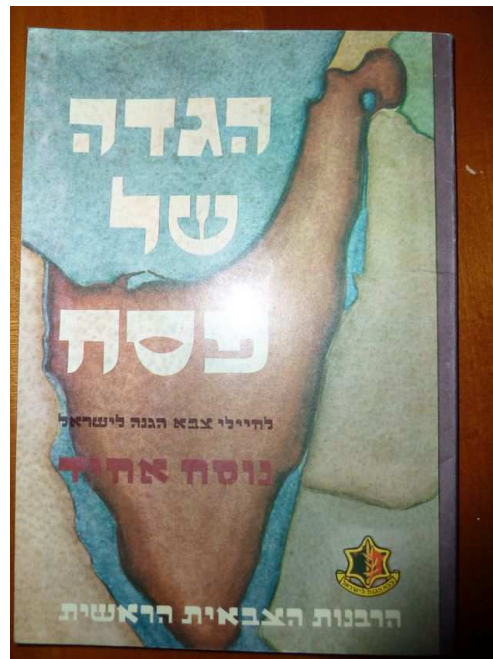
