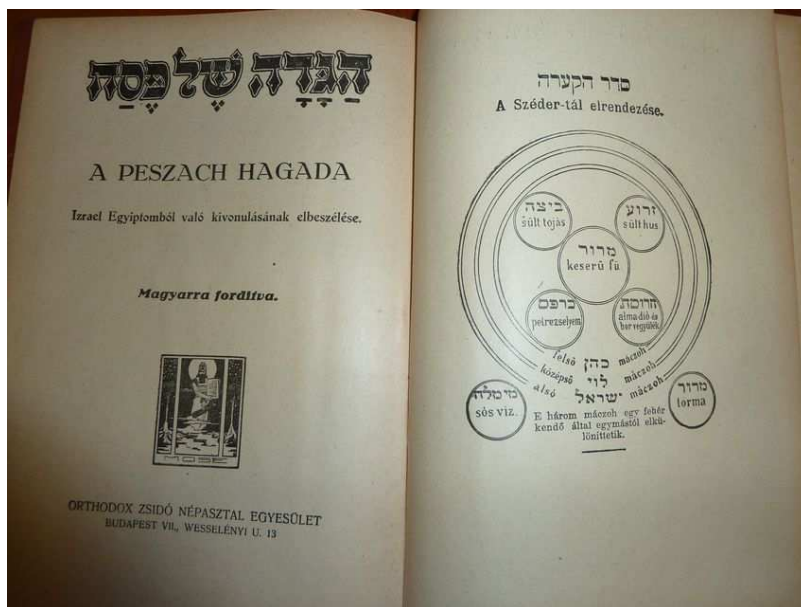

**1942 Wohlgemuth, Juda Ari. Pesach 1942 in Novosibirsk (Siberia)**

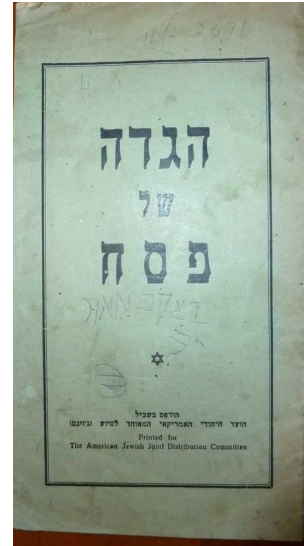

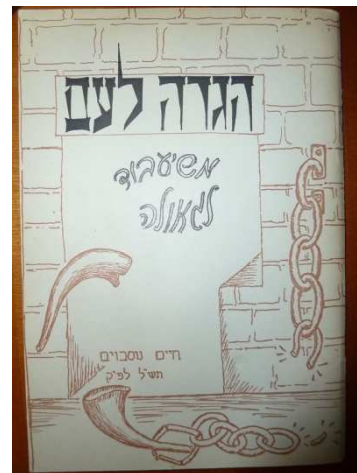
