Original wrappers, 23cm, 19 pp, vg condition. Richard Howard Stafford Crossman OBE (15 Dec 1907- 5 April 1974) was a British author and Labour Party politician. Secretary of State for Social Services, Lord President of the Council and Leader of the House of Commons under Harold Wilson, he resigned after Labour's election defeat in 1970 from the Labour front-bench to be editor of the New Statesman. A prominent socialist intellectual, he became one of the Labour Party's leading Zionists and anti-communists. Crossman is noted for his colourful, if highly subjective three-volume Diaries of a Cabinet Minister, which are an acknowledged source for the popular television series, 'Yes, Minister.' Crossman was a great admirer of Chaim Weizmann and wanted to write a biography of him. Crossman became interested in Zionist and Palestine issues when Ernest Bevin appointed him to the 'Anglo-American Committee of Enquiry regarding the problems of European Jewry and Palestine' in 1946. He wrote Palestine Mission (1946) about the Anglo-American Committee of Enquiry and A Nation Reborn (1960), giving his personal impressions of Weizmann, Bevin and Ben-Gurion.
