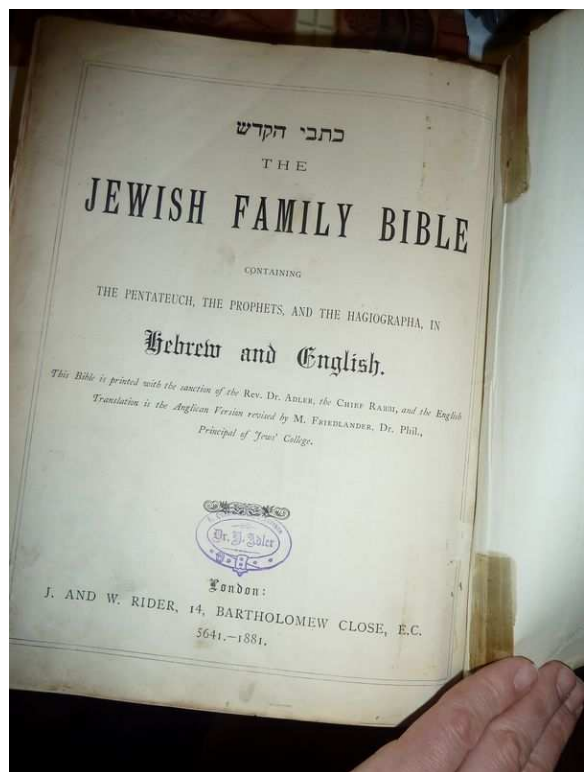
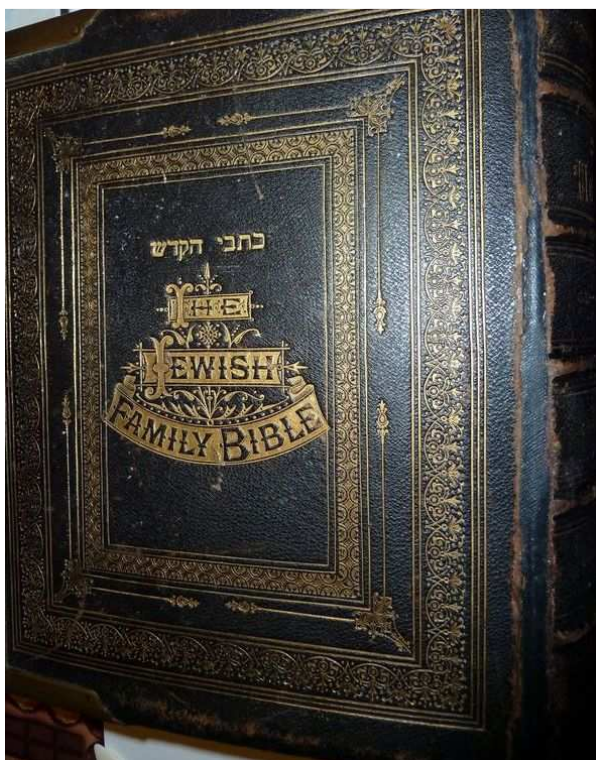

15 ITEMS OF NOTE

THE JEWISH EQUIVALENT OF THE VICTORIAN FAMILY BIBLE – CHIEF RABBI HERMANN ADLER'S COPY



1. **FRIEDLANDER, MICHAEL. - KITVE HA-KODESH - THE JEWISH FAMILY BIBLE, CONTAINING THE PENTATEUCH, THE PROPHETS AND THE HAGIOGRAPHA IN HEBREW AND ENGLISH.** This Bible is printed with the sanction of the Rev. Dr. Adler, Chief Rabbi, and the English translation is the Anglican version revised by M. Friedlander, Principal of Jews' College. *London J. and W. Rider 1881*

Rebacked original boards and spine, gilt titles and decorations, all edges gilt. Kitve ha-Kodesh - The Holy Bible on half title. 1,978 + (2) pp. Text in English and Hebrew. Some wear and repairs, minor tearing to title



page and one or two other early pages before the start of the bible. Some scuffing to the leather binding. This copy belonged to Dr H Adler who became Chief Rabbi in 1891, and it has his stamp on the title page. In the 'Jerusalem Bible' published by Koren in 1997 it says that this 'Jewish Family Bible' 1881 edited by Michael Friedlander and with the sanction of Chief Rabbi Adler, was used as a basis for the Koren edition because of "two important merits, it is faithful to the Masora, the received Hebrew text, and it retained as much as Jewish sentiment permitted of the unsurpassed language and rhythm of the 'Authorized Version' of 1611." A rare Jewish Bible COPAC lists only 3 copies of this edition, Worldcat does not list any outside the UK [ref: 16531]



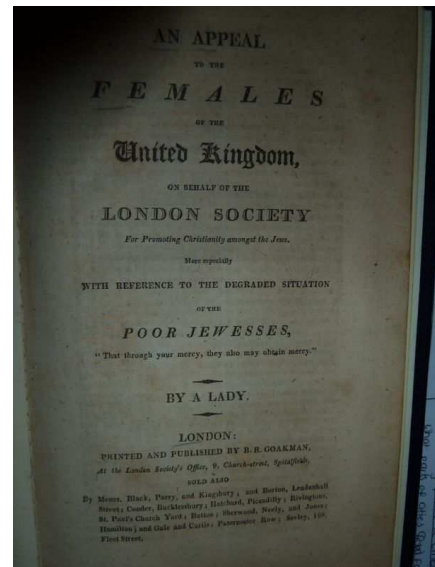

"The Committee of the London Society feel particularly desirous of recommending the case of the poor Jewesses to the benevolent consideration of the Ladies of Great Britain and Ireland" Worldcat records no copies in the USA or any outside the UK.

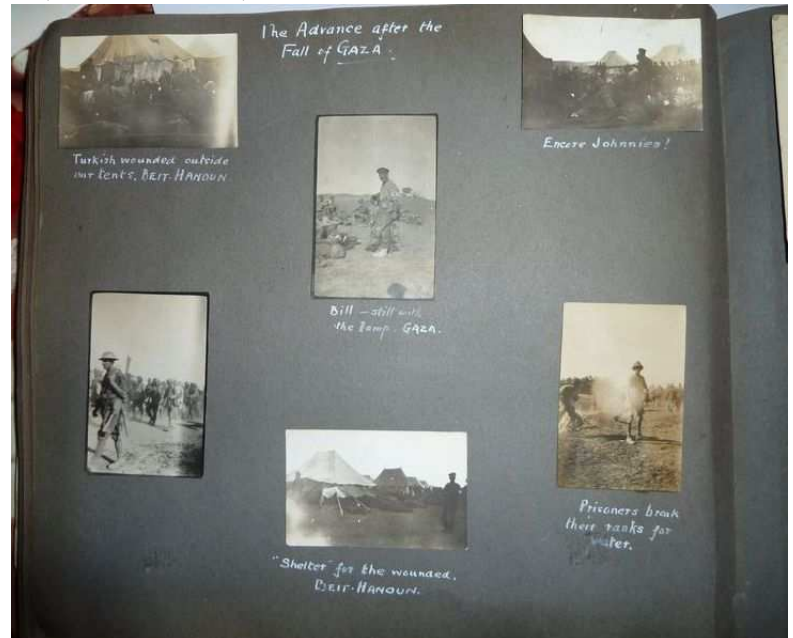

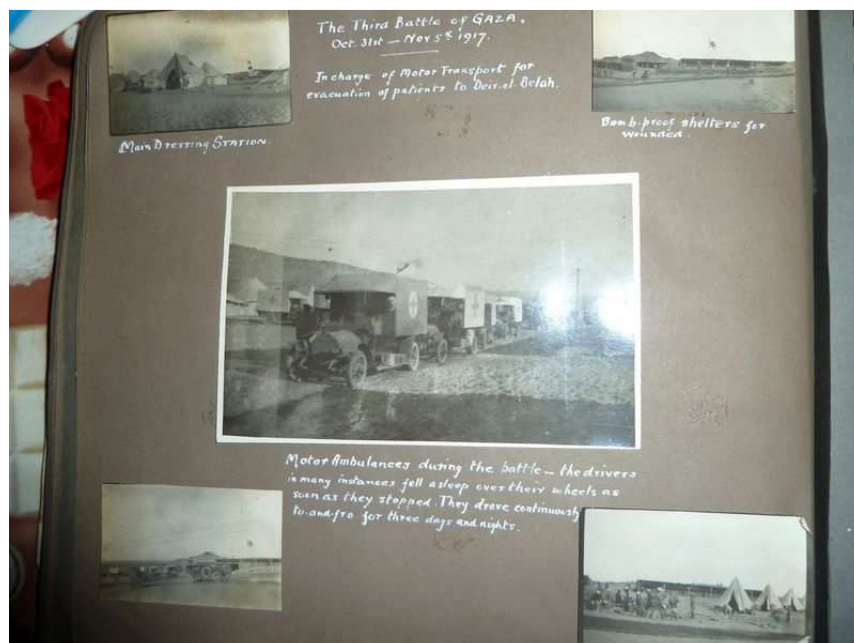
3. **THIRD EAST ANGLIAN FIELD AMBULANCE OFFICERS CORPS (ROYAL ARMY MEDICAL CORPS) 54TH DIVISION, XXIST CORPS WW1 PHOTOGRAPHIC ALBUM PALESTINE** Album of photographs and ephemera (including postcards, newspaper cuttings, notices, invitations, curiosities and other commemorative documents) from 1914-1919 relating to the activities of the Third East Anglian Field Ambulance Officers Corps in Gallipoli, Palestine and Egypt and their base in Norwich. 1914-1919

Cloth 26cm x 23cm with items mounted on about 80 thick brown leaves.

Interestingly a Mezuzah has been stuck in the album (upside down!). There is a set of rules for the hospital in Shallufa West, and German casualty tag. Mainly good condition but some photographs slightly faded. [ref: 3634]



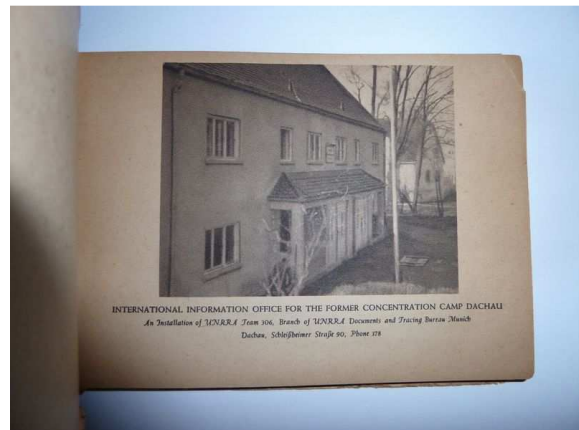
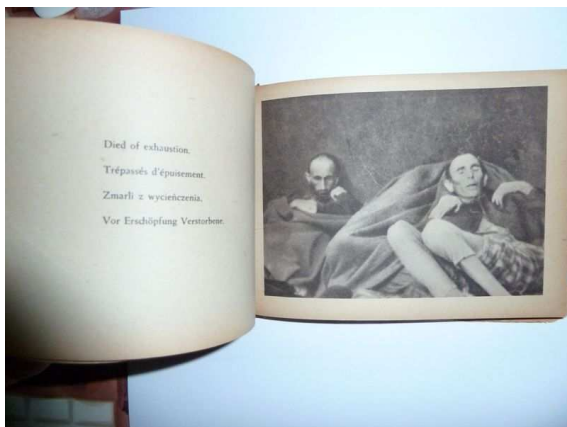

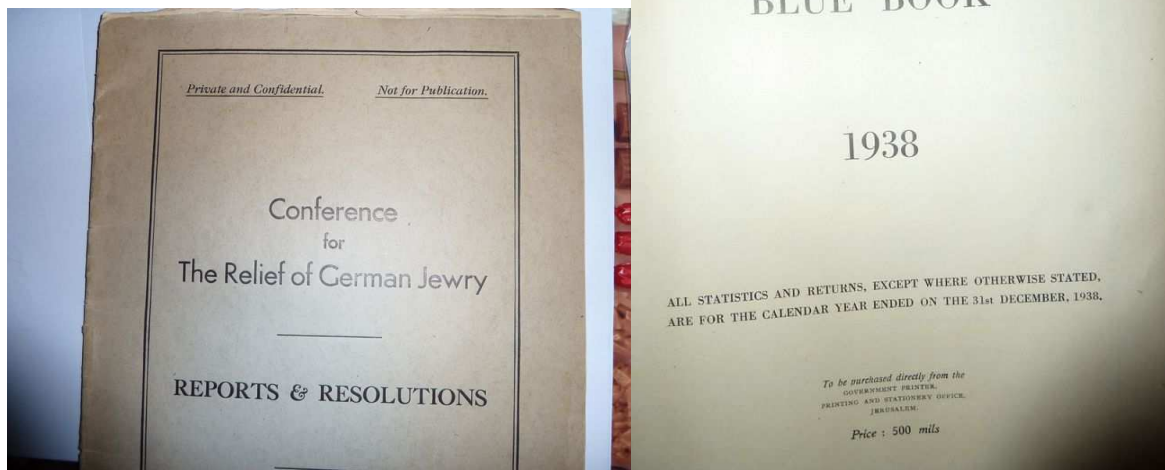


5. [HOLOCAUST] CONFERENCE FOR THE RELIEF OF GERMAN JEWRY: REPORTS AND RESOLUTIONS - (PRIVATE AND CONFIDENTIAL, NOT FOR PUBLICATION) *London Joint Foreign Committee c 1933*

Original wrappers, 29cm, 39 + (1) pp, ex library, the text block is separated from the wrappers, internally it is very clean. The Conference was convened by the Joint Foreign Committee of the Board of Deputies of British Jews and the Anglo-Jewish Association, the Alliance Israelite Universelle, the American Jewish Congress and the Comite Delegations Juives. The Conference was held in London at Woburn House from October 29 to November 1, 1933 and chaired by Neville Laski. The Conference brought together representatives of the principal Jewish associations and the Jewish communities of all parts of the world to consider methods of dealing with the problems of the refugees. There were delegates from the Jewish Agency, the Jewish Colonisation Association, Agudath Israel, and from the Jewish communities in nearly every country in Europe, the United States and Palestine.

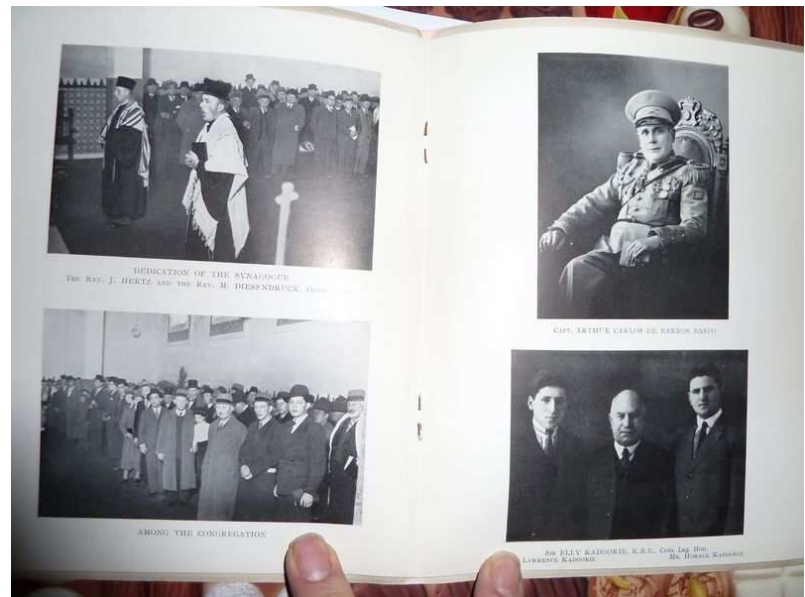
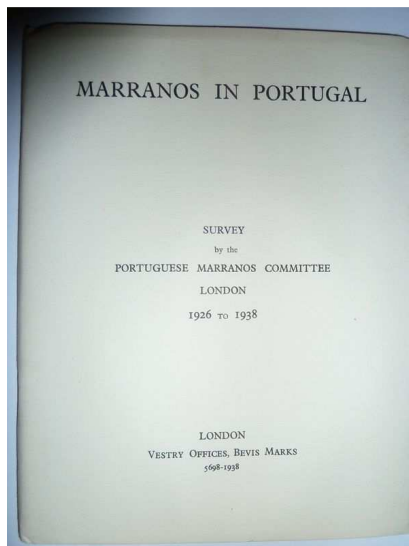

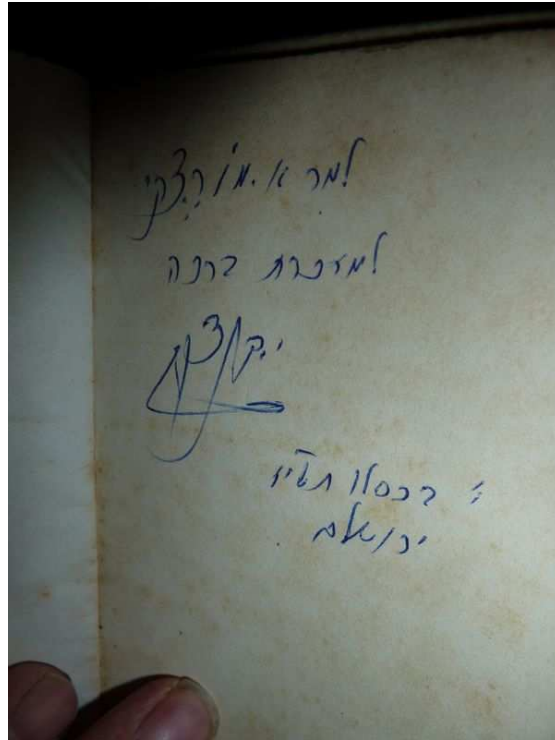

There is an inscription in Hebrew from Yitschak Ben Zevi (1884-1963) the second President of the State of Israel, dated 1956. 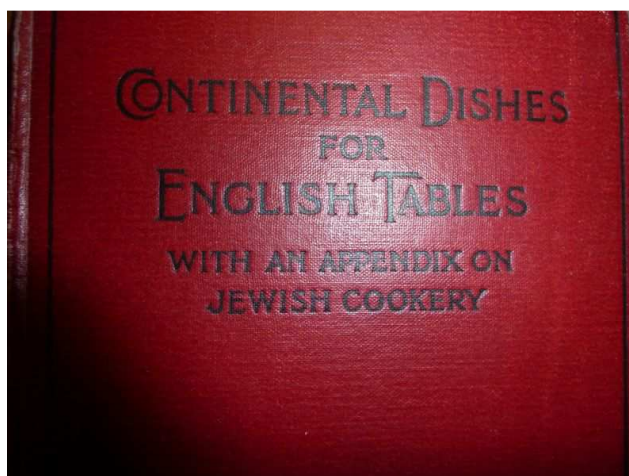
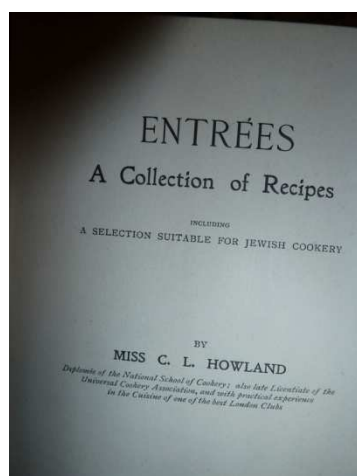

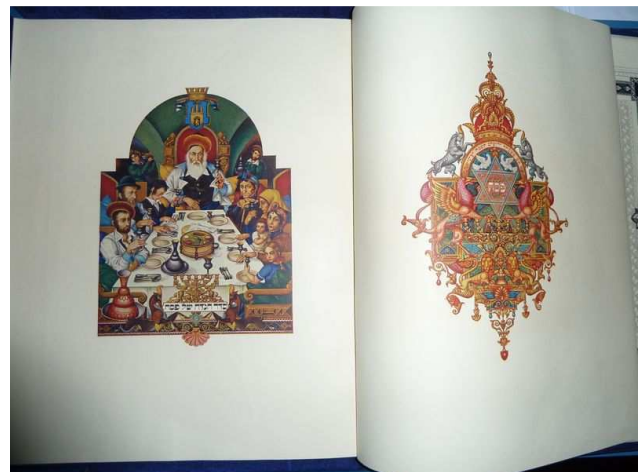
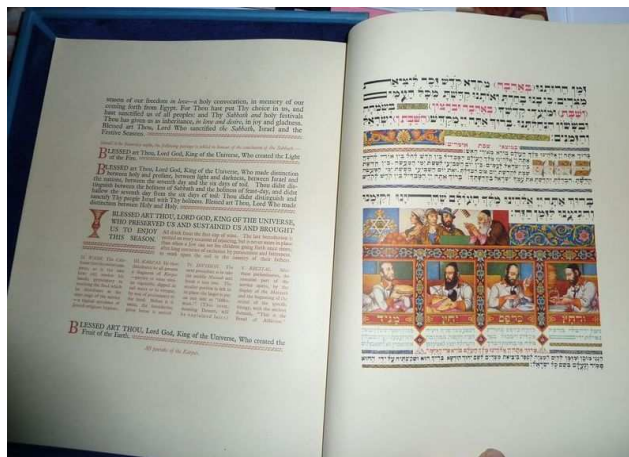
