## An Extremely Rare and Historically Significant Order of Service

The terms and final form of the Palestine Mandate were finalized in 1922. This is an Order of Service to give Thanksgiving to this momentous occasion which ultimately led to the creation of the modern State of Israel.



## Calendars and Lurahot

The next 46 items are Calendars/Lurahot. These highly ephemeral items reflect the social history and religious customs of the communities that produced them. The ones listed here are not particularly old, but they are very interesting as the majority of them were produced in Communist regimes behind the Iron Curtain and reflect an aspect of Jewish life during a unique set of circumstances in modern Jewish life.

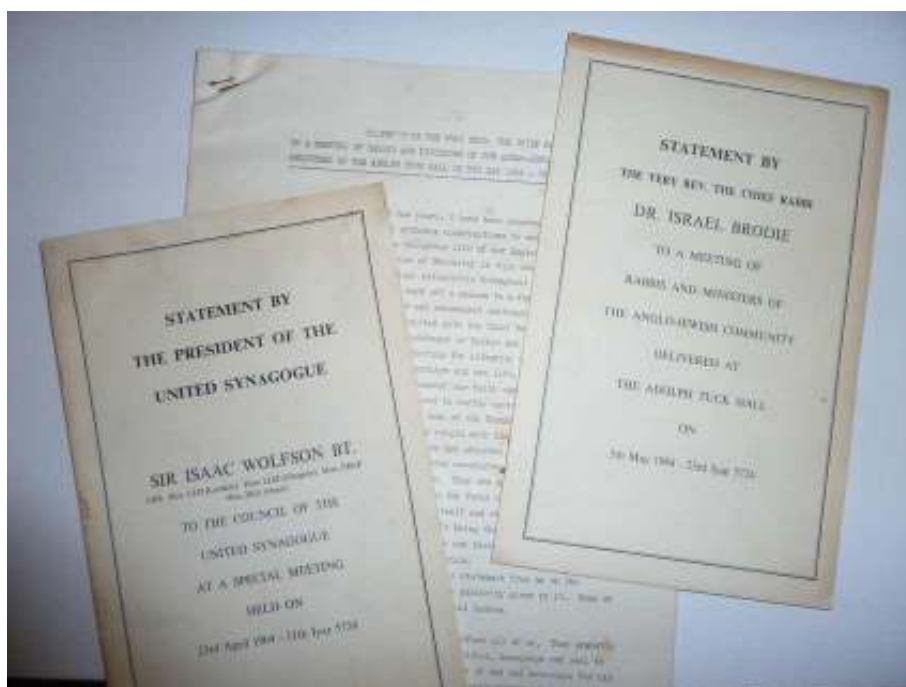

### **"The Jacobs Affair"**

In 1959 Rabbi Louis Jacobs was appointed as a tutor at Jews College in London. It was expected that upon the retirement of Rabbi Epstein in 1961, Rabbi Jacobs would be appointed the Principal and that this would eventually lead to him becoming the Chief Rabbi of the UK. However, Chief Rabbi Brodie refused to appoint him as Principal on the basis that he expressed views in his 1957 book *We Have Reason to Believe* which were considered unorthodox. Rabbi Jacobs then resigned his

position at Jews' College in protest. There was a second stage to the "Affair" when in 1964, Rabbi Jacobs' previous position as the Rabbi of the New West End Synagogue became available. Chief Rabbi Brodie blocked Rabbi Jacobs re-appointment – consequently, about half the membership established an independent synagogue called the New London Synagogue and under the leadership of Rabbi Jacobs. This was the catalyst for the development of the Masorti Movement.

The following documents are statements by the United Synagogue related to the 'Affair.' **Item 83** is a programme for the Society for the Study of Jewish Theology which was an organization set up by Rabbi Jacob's supporters until the New London Synagogue was established.
