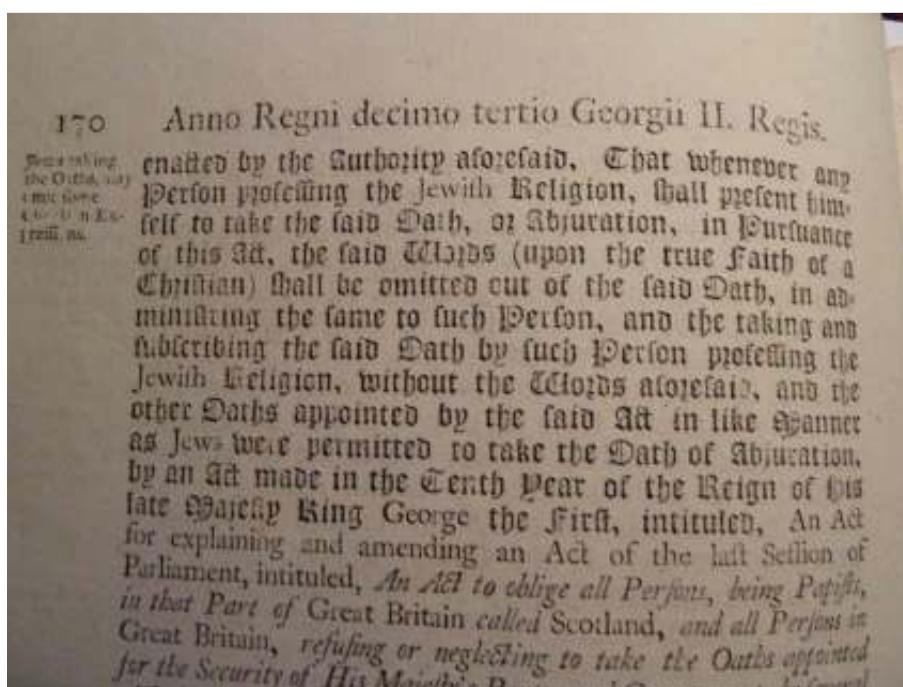

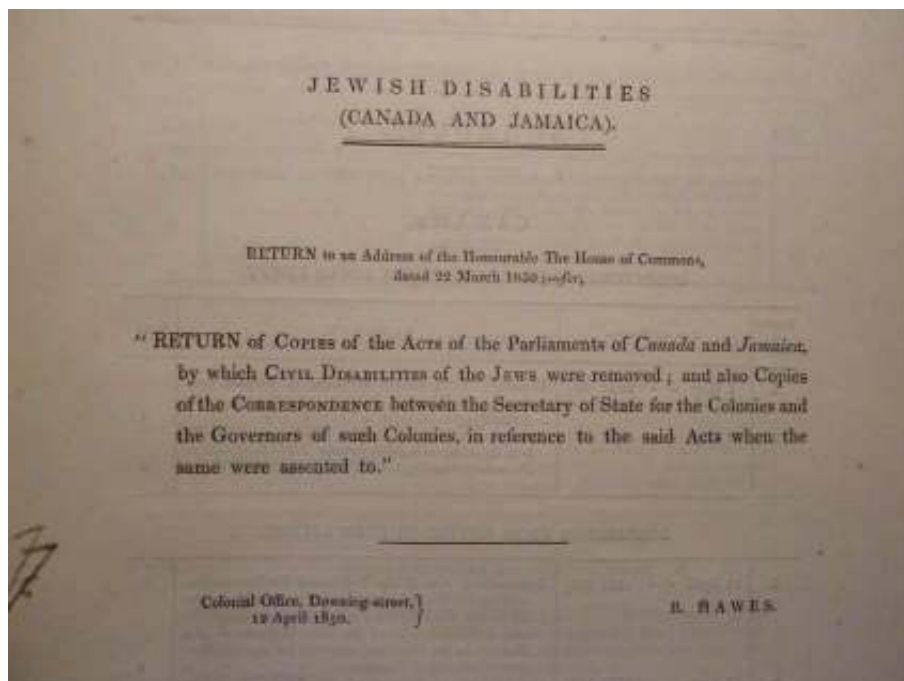
The first British Act of Parliament for the naturalization of Jews in any part of the Empire.



1. BRITISH GOVERNMENT, PARLIAMENT. - **AN ACT FOR NATURALIZING SUCH FOREIGN PROTESTANTS, AND OTHERS THEREIN MENTIONED, AS ARE SETTLED, OR SHALL SETTLE IN ANY OF HIS MAJESTY'S COLONIES IN AMERICA. (ACT OF 1739 FOR NATURALIZING OF JEWS AND QUAKERS IN AMERICA)** London, John Baskett 1739.

Dis-bound, small folio 7 pp. Interestingly the Jewish people in the Colonies of North America could be naturalized before the Jews in England. Known as the 'Plantation Act,' it allowed foreigners who had resided in any of His Majesty's colonies for seven years or more to be naturalized by taking oaths of allegiance, supremacy, and abjuration, and also receiving the sacrament. However, special provisions were made in favour of the Quakers and Jews who were exempted from receiving the sacrament. Quakers were allowed to affirm instead of taking the oath, while Jews could omit the words 'on the true faith of a Christian.' 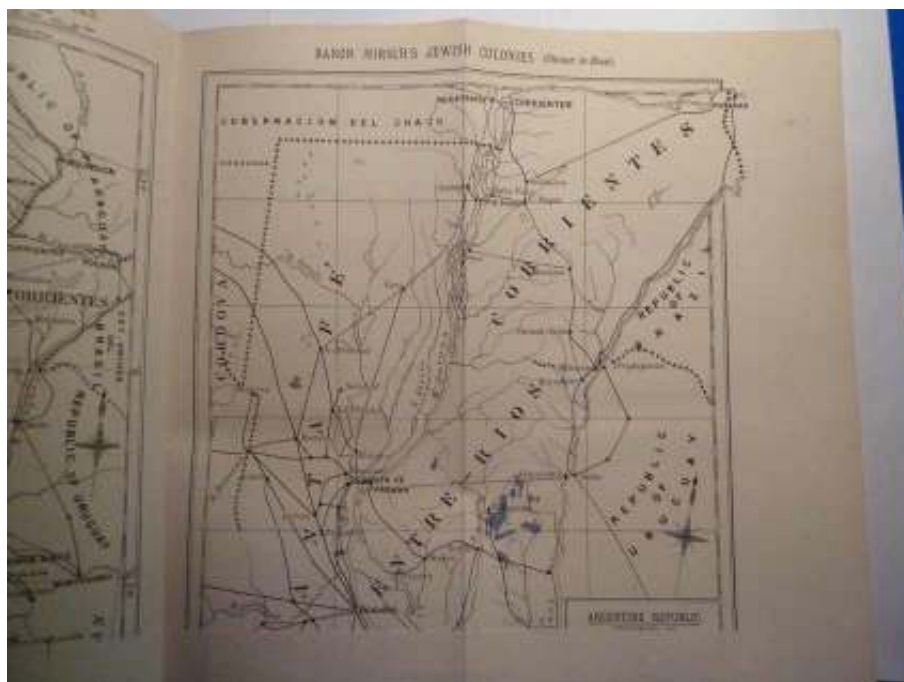

Document No. 227. Presumably this was printed and distributed in the House of Commons as part of the debate on the removal of Civil Disabilities of the Jews in England. Lord Rothschild was elected as a Member of Parliament in 1850, however felt unable to take the oath requiring him to say the words 'on the true faith of a Christian.' However, this rule was amended in 1858, and at that point, he took his seat. In this respect both Canada and Jamaica preceded the Great Britain this being achieved in both of these colonies in 1832. 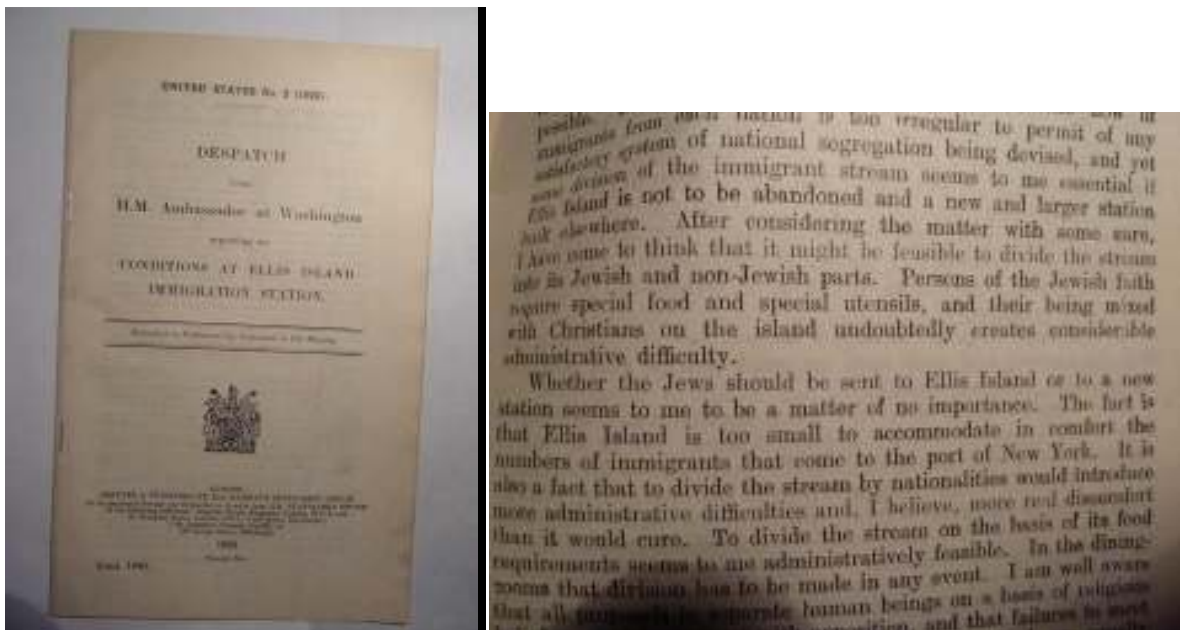

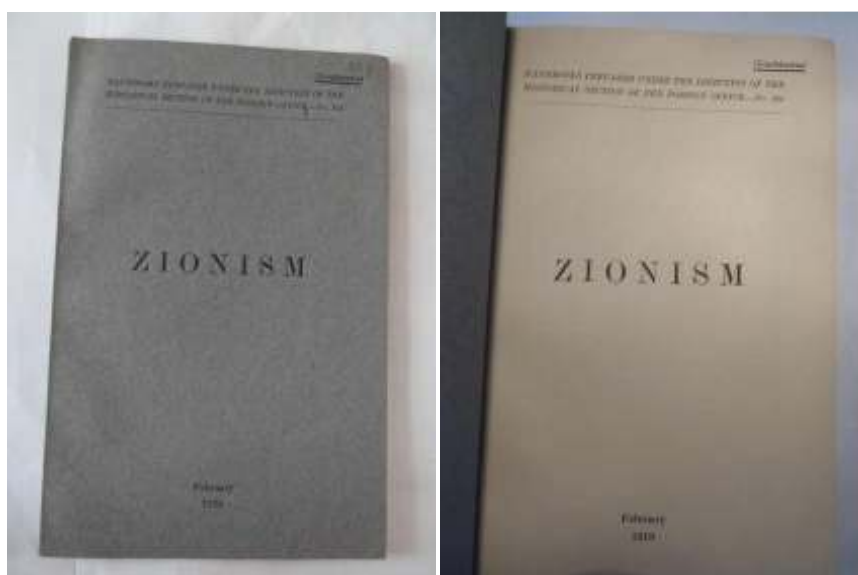

One of a series of Handbooks that were produced for the British delegates of the 32 Allied nations at the Paris Peace Conference which convened in January 1919 with the aim of securing future world peace and lasted just over a year. The conference concluded a number of treaties and led to the creation of the League of Nations. These reports were classified as "Confidential" and covered the geography, economic conditions and political history of the territory. They were reprinted in 1920 for public consumption in green wrappers (but often with some censoring). This copy is one the reports that was produced for the delegates and is the "British Government's Handbook on Zionism". This extraordinary document traces the history of Zionism. Chapter headings include: From the Bible to Zionism, the French Revolution, Montefiore, Mordechai Noah (pre-cursors to Zionism), Jewish Emancipation in England, Anti-Semitism and Modern Zionism.... Herzl, The Zionist Congresses, The Jewish National Fund and the Zionist Proposals for the Peace Conference which sought to implement the Balfour Declaration. [ref: 11305]

He was also an expert on Chinese Jews, about whom he wrote a book. Peter Meshullam worked for him in the 1860s and helped him in his dealings with the local Arabs. 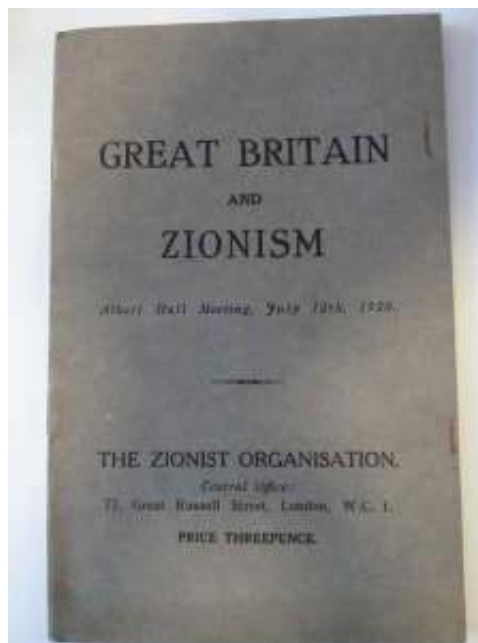

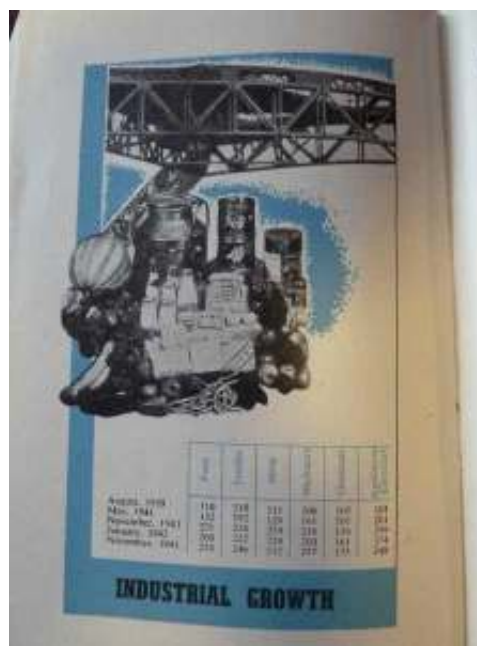
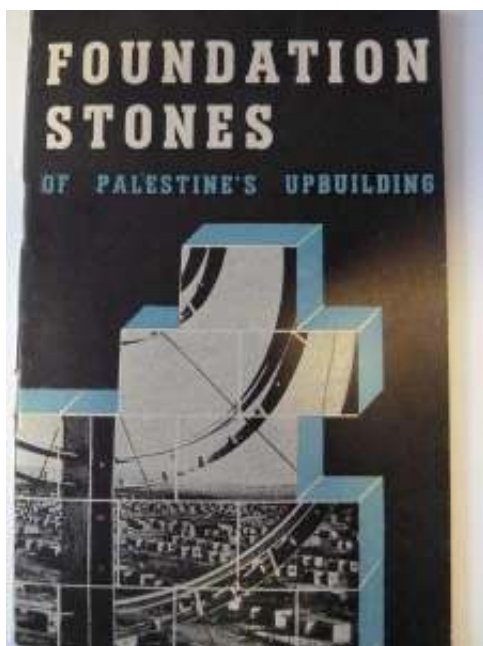
“A demonstration, organised by the English Zionist Federation, to thank the British Government for the San Remo decision to incorporate the Balfour Declaration for the establishment of a Jewish National Home in Palestine in the Treaty of Peace with Turkey was held at the Albert Hall, London on Monday night, July 12th, 1920. It was the most extraordinary meeting in the annals of Anglo-Jewry. Long before the meeting there was something in the nature of a Jewish pilgrimage westward and the vast hall was besieged by a huge crowd. Fully, 30,000 applications had been received for admission, and many who were too late for tickets came in the hope that place would be found for them. The Hall holds more than 10,000 and very soon it was packed from arena to top most gallery.....” (from the first page of the pamphlet)
