And he walked in various lands: in the land of his birth and upbringing, in the land of his academic and higher Jewish studies, and in the land of his adoption and his great and manifold spiritual activities. And everywhere he walked with a firm step.



And everywhere he affirmed life: Jewish life, human life, dignified life." Moses Gaster (September 17, 1856 – March 5, 1939) was a Romanian-born Jewish-British scholar, the Hakham of the Spanish and Portuguese congregation, London, and a Hebrew linguist. [ref: 8524]
