he assumed office as Chief Rabbi. This sermon was originally delivered at the Barmitzab of his only son, Solomon Alfred Adler and was printed at the request of one of his congregants Mr Charles Samuel. £45

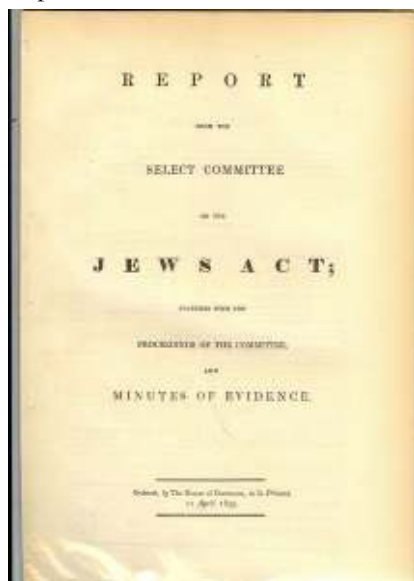

Oblong folio, conservation case-bound using fully acid free materials the decorative colour wrapper in on top has been inset to prevent any damage. Published under the auspices of the Central Committee of the Liberated Jews in the British Zone. The text is in English, Yiddish, Hebrew and German. Each language has its own title page. Printed on card. Contains 115 photographs of the destruction of the Jews by the Nazis. Each page contains 3 or 4 pictures. The introduction of the book poignantly describes its purpose:

"The incentive to produce this collection gave us our deepest desire to show the world the crimes of Germany, to give expression to the throttled cry of pain of the Jews. The desire to bring back our memories of Jewish Settlements which were drowned in torrents of Jewish Blood. May the world have this knowledge and ponder on it. When words are too weak and too poor to convey the destruction and extermination of Jewish life, may these pictures found by accident on arrested SS Soldiers, speak for themselves of the bestiality which will forever bring shame on human kind"

Second edition with additions. Original cloth, folio. Aramaic, Hebrew with German translation. Tractate Berachot. This was the first translation of the Talmud into a modern European language. Astonishingly the first edition issued in 1842 was dedicated to Tzar Nicholas 1 and had a printed dedication to him. The Tzar initially saw it as a vehicle to assimilate Russian Jews but when he realised Pinner's scholarly intentions, he refused to put in any more funding into the project. By the time this edition came out, he no longer had any connection to it. In addition to being an Historical curiosity it is a genuinely scholarly work. Binding worn, most of backstrip missing. 29 cm paper covered board, 6 pp + 6 tables. From the introduction "The following statistics contain a summary of the chief official records of the most important Jewish Communal Institutions between 1873 and 1893, in as far as they are likely to

throw any light upon the additions to the Jewish Population of London due to Russo Jewish immigration. " Worldcat lists 3 copies JNUL, JTS and the BL Joseph Jacobs was a noted folklorist, editor of the Jewish Year book and the Jewish Encyclopedia. £175

35. **Heschel, Abraham (Joshua) A Concise Dictionary of Hebrew Philosophical Terms.**
Cincinnati, Hebrew Union College, 1941 [7276]

Original cloth, 28cm, Mimeographed for use in the Philosophy Classes of the Hebrew Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion. Printed on one side only. Heschel one the leading Jewish Theologians of the 20th Century arrived in the USA in 1940 escaping Nazi Europe. He first went to Hebrew Union College in Cincinnati before moving to JTS. Probably the first book that Heschel wrote in English, and it is the first English book in the select bibliography of Kaplan, E. Spiritual Radical: Abraham Joshua Heschel in America. " Heschel wrote in the preface to this work:

The object of the present book is to offer the English equivalents of the medieval philosophical vocabulary including the most important philosophical terms of the Hebrew literature of modern times. It is designed as a concise dictionary, not as an encyclopedic compendium and does not present interpretations of the concepts denoted. £95
