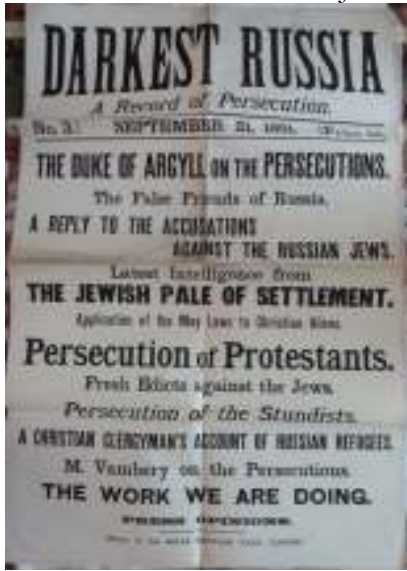

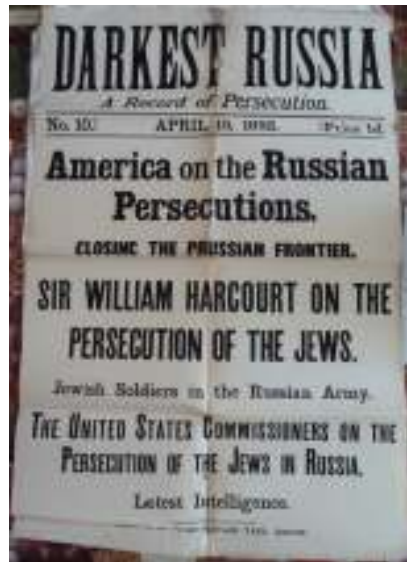

1. **An Act for the Relief of Persons of the Jewish Religion elected to Municipal Offices.** [31st July 1845]. London, 1845. [5043] *Folio disbound.* £375

This Act removed the need for "Receiving the Sacraments of the Lord's Supper as a Qualification for Certain Offices and Employments" Instead it allowed 'Persons of the Jewish Religion' to declare

"I A. B., being a Person professing the Jewish Religion having conscientious scruples against subscribing the Declaration..... do solemnly sincerely, and truly declare That I will not exercise any Power or Authority or Influence which to injure or weaken the Protestant church as it is by Law established in England....."

This Act of Parliament was another step towards emancipation.

Folio, 30cm, disbound. - (1) + 714-734 (ie 22 pages). Abraham Goldsmid was one of the more prominent members of the wealthy Goldsmid family of English financiers. About 1777, Abraham and his brother, Benjamin, founded a brokerage partnership in London. Their business became very successful and eventually became involved in major government contracts. After the death of his brother in 1808, Abraham took over, but soon after that, the fortunes of the business quickly declined, leaving him with unbearable debt. Payment of a very considerable loan was due on Sept. 28, 1810; the next morning Goldsmid was found dead with a pistol by his side. Over several years, the Goldsmid firm made great efforts to repay the loan. In 1820, Parliament, upon the creditors' petition, annulled the remaining debt.

"The purpose of this short pamphlet is to give some picture of the part that has been played by the refugees from Nazi tyranny in helping to secure the victory of the United Nations over the forces of Fascism and Nazism' from the foreword. Worldcat lists 2 copies NLI, and one in Germany, COPAC lists one at Sheffield University. The only copies in the USA are microform (Harvard and NYPL)

Various organizations lobbied and presented their views to the United Nations Special Committee on Palestine (UNSCOP) the Jewish Agency being one of the most important of these. This pamphlet deals with the Economic Effects of Zionism, The Social and Cultural Effects of Jewish Development etc.

Original wrappers. Very good condition, 15pp. 18cm. I could identify no institutional copies either on Worldcat or COPAC.

This was to bring together various Jewish organisations to provide input to the Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) of the UN. These organisations included the Anglo-Jewish Association, the Alliance Israelite Universelle, the American Jewish Committee. In the aftermath of the war there were genocide, refugee and human rights issues to be addressed.

There are also some illustrations of the synagogue.

First Yiddish edition of Allbutt's The Wife's Handbook. The work contains numerous advertisements (some illustrated) showing contraceptive devices, the pessary etc., and there are also advertisements for feeding bottles for children and magazines such as Hints of Marriage and Monthly Nursing. According to Alec Craig's The Banned Books of England (pp 113-114), as a result of a complaint by the Leeds Vigilance Association in 1887 Dr Allbutt was struck off the medical register for publishing this book on contraception, and "it has been suggested that part of Dr Allbutt's offence was the rather blatant advertisements in the book", although Craig says there is no evidence for this from the General Medical Council, which he goes on to quote: "In the opinion of the Council, Mr Allbutt has committed the offence charged against him, that is to say, of having



published and publicly caused to be sold, a work entitled The Wife's Handbook, in London and elsewhere, at so low a price as to bring the work within the reach of both sexes to the detriment of public morals".

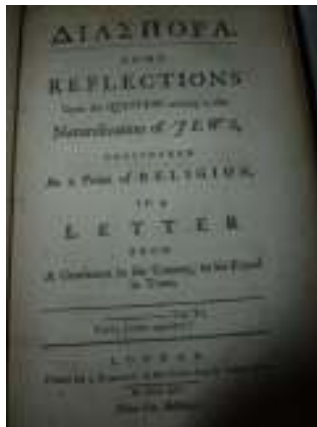

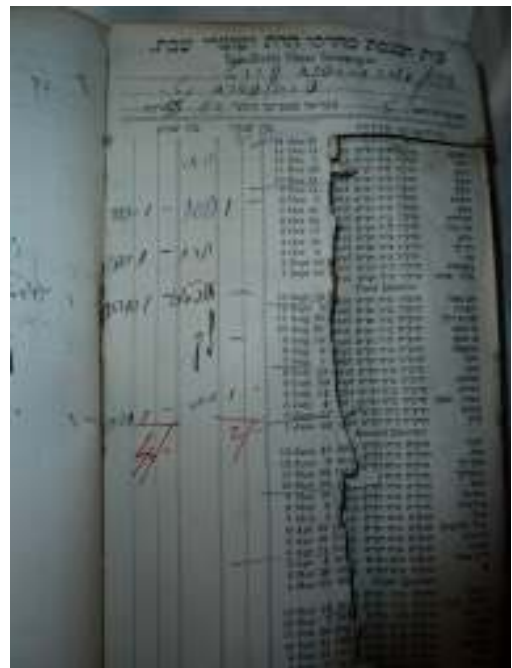

The Jewish Chronicle published reports of the outrages situation in Russia on a regular basis however Mr Gladstone suggested that it should publish the facts regarding the persecution consecutively and collectively. "On July 17, 1891, accordingly, there was distributed with it as a supplement the first number of a monthly periodical, **Darkest Russia**, A Journal of Persecution, produced under the auspices of the of the Russo-Jewish Committee but printed and distributed like the Chronicle itself, by Asher Myers. 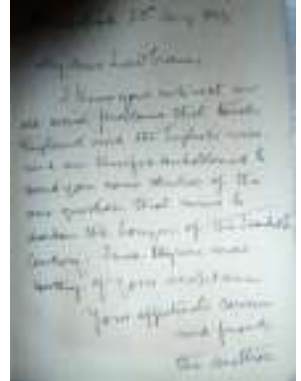
