

The United Nations Special Committee on Palestine (UNSCOP) was the committee that recommended the Partition of Palestine before the vote on the 29th November 1947 which ultimately led to the establishment of the State of Israel. On the blood libel in Morocco in 1863 and Sir Moses Montefiore's trip to Morocco and his intervention on behalf of the Jews of Morocco. In 1863 the Jews of Morocco were in grave danger due to an accusation that the Jews of the city Safi poisoned a Spanish customs official. Four Jews were arrested, and the Deputy Consul of Spain demanded their execution. Two were indeed executed, and Sir Moses Montefiore succeeded in releasing the remaining two. Montefiore met with the

Sultan, and managed to obtain his promise to grant rights and ensure the well-being of the Moroccan Jews. The book provides some of the correspondence from Sir Moses. It also includes a poem by Amshevitz and also concerns of Rabbi Nathan Adler. See Lehman Bibliography of Montefiore page 124. Friedberg 1662. 
Majesty's Government when they undertook their recent actions in Palestine led them to draw the following conclusions:-

i. That the Hagana and its associated force the Palmach (working under the political control of prominent members of the Jewish Agency) have been engaging in carefully planned movements of sabotage and violence under the guise of "the Jewish Resistance Movement".

ii. That the Irgun Zvai Leumi and the Stern Group have worked since last Autumn in co-operation with the Hagana High Command on certain of these operations; and


iii. That the broadcasting station "Kol Israel", which claims to be "the Voice of the Resistance Movement" and which was working under the general direction of the Jewish Agency has been supporting these organisations. [ref: 22247]



Louis Marshall (December 14, 1856 – September 11, 1929) was an American corporate, constitutional and civil rights lawyer as well as a mediator and Jewish community leader who worked to secure religious, political, and cultural freedom for all minority groups. Among the founders of the American Jewish Committee (AJC), he defended Jewish and minority rights and, though not a Zionist, he supported the Balfour Declaration. He was also a conservationist, and was instrumental in reestablishing the New York State College of Forestry at Syracuse University, which evolved into today's State University of New York College of Environmental Science and Forestry.






