#### ICONIC - YOU DON'T HAVE TO BE JEWISH POSTERS

These posters appeared with several different nationalities including Asians, Indians, and Afros. Whitey Ruben, owner of Levy's Jewish Rye bread selected the DDB company for its advertising campaign. With an annual advertising budget that was less than \$50,000, the agency viewed the account as its opportunity to gain attention in the Manhattan advertising community by introducing ethnicity into a marketing campaign. The DDB campaign elevated Levy's to the largest seller of rve bread in New York. In 1981, the copywriter William Taubin was inducted into the Art Director's Hall of Fame and the photographer, William Zieff went on to direct films in Hollywood, including My Girl, Private Benjamin and The Main Event with Barbara Streisand. In an interview in 2001 regarding these famous images he said, 'We wanted normal looking people, not blond perfectly proportioned models. I saw the Indian on the street - he was an engineer for the New York Central. The Chinese guy worked in a restaurant and the kid we found in Harlem. They all had great faces. Interesting faces. Expressive faces.' These posters were repeatedly copied and parodied by many people. Some of them are part of the permanent collection in the Smithsonian Institution and were featured at the Oakland Museum Poster Exposition in 1999. 



In a paper read by Mr. Charles Booth before the Royal Statistical Society a short time ago, figures as to the Jewish population of Tower Hamlets and Bethnal Green were given, based upon the most careful inquiry into the condition of the people in those localities. The total Jewish population of the East End was estimated by him at 45,000. As to his mode of arriving at these figures he says: "It is not "difficult to recognise the Jews; the school board visitors know them well. They congregate together; whole blocks of buildings and whole streets are recognised as "theirs; in other streets they may count as half the population, and then again there are those that are scattered. To form my estimate of the numbers I have classified the streets, and taking the inhabitants as all Jews where Jews prevail and half Jews for the mixed streets, and omitting altogether those who are to be found scattered among the Christians, I have obtained a proportion of families which indicate a population of over 40,000." The additional 5,000 are for the other portions of the East End. Another estimate based on the assumption that the Jewish death rate per 1,000 for the East End is the same as that of the remainder of the population, places the total at 34,000. As, however, the Jewish population is being so constantly augmented by immigrants from abroad the average of ages amongst them must be altogether different from those of a fixed and long resident people. Taking, therefore, Mr. Booth's figures as most likely to be correct we should deduce from the fact of a total population of 45,000 that the numbers at work would at most be a little over 40 cont., or say 20,000, and, assuming that 44 per cent. of these were tailors, according the above proportion, the total number of Jewish or foreign tailors in the East End and appear to be about 9,000. 





There are many photographs of Jewish life in the Pale of Settlement and Eastern Europe including Pinsk, Cracow, Grodno, Dvinsk, Libau, Lodz and St Petersburg. There are also some photos of immigrant Jewish Life in London and emigrant depots in Hamburg and New York. Evans-Gordon became the MP (Member of Parliament) for Stepney in East London in 1900. This was a district with a large immigrant Jewish population. He was strongly anti-immigrant, and he was a member of the Royal Commission for Alien Immigration which led to the Alien's Act of 1905. This book is a record of his travels through the Pale of Settlement in an attempt to present evidence that the level of persecution of the Jewish community was exaggerated. The book has some fascinating photographs from his journey and there is some interesting information about the Jews of Eastern Europe.

These alleged promises to the Arab side given before the later BALFOUR DECLARATION OF 1917 were therefore considered by the supporters of the JEWISH CAUSE as being without legal validity.
