




First edition. Original card wrappers, 48 pp, 12.5cm. Illustrated by Lloyd McNeill. An alternative Passover Haggadah, focusing on the freedom and rights of man, entirely in English. The editor mentions in the introduction the assassination of Martin Luther King (March 1968) and citations of his words are integrated into the Haggadah alongside citations from Mahatma Gandhi, Hannah Arendt, Buber, Emanuel Ringlblum (about the Warsaw Ghetto) and others. Numerous texts concern the rights of African Americans in the USA and other current events. The illustrations were made by the American Jazz flautist and artist Lloyd McNeill. Apparently this is the first Passover Haggadah ever illustrated by an African-American artist. *OCLC 8112470* [ref: 23275]





The pages are heavily yellowed, some glue between the last page and rear wrapper has removed a few words on the inside of the rear wrapper, otherwise it is in good condition. DPs who were unable to emigrate, remained in the camp long after most Jewish DPs had left Europe. Though a JDC presence remained in the camp at least until 1954, Foehrenwald was taken over by the German administration on December 1, 1951. THE JEWS OF AUSTRIA

Population; Refugees.

In 1938, when Hitler invaded Austria, there were about 190,000 Jews in the country, or 3% of the population, distributed approximately as follows (census of 1933-34):

The Jews were concentrated in the cities of Vienna, Linz, Gratz, Annsbruck, Neustadt, Neunkirchen, Eisenstadt, Mattersburg, Mattersdorf, and entsch Kreuz. The number of Jews living in Austria in 1938, according to the interpretation of the Nuremberg laws, was about 250,000.

The number of Jews left in Austria in 1943 was estimated varyingly between 5,000 and 15,000. Some 70,000 had been deported to Poland or Annsenstadt (Terezin) in Czechoslovakia. About 100,000 emigrated to other countries; approximately 50,000 to the United States; 20,000 to Great Britain and the Dominions; 15,000 to Palestine; 15,000 to South American and



This is a collection of reports on the Jewish communities of seventeen countries under Nazi occupation in 1943, prepared between the spring of that year and 1944. Most were done at the request of a government agency; a few were added because the communities were of interest from the point of view of size or character. They were prepared by the staff of the Institute, for a number of countries with the collaboration of outside experts.

None of these reports was meant to give a complete picture of Jewish life; all were intended to answer a series of precise questions. Some important aspects of Jewish life, such as cultural activity, are not fully discussed because the emphasis was elsewhere. Other aspects were lacking because war conditions made information impossible to obtain. Most of the information we do present, however, is as complete and as accurate as was possible to get, and the reader will find some of it not readily available in other sources.

The Committee's recommendations addressed the matter of immigration and the future government of Palestine. Although one of many committees of inquiry which examined the situation in Palestine, the Anglo-American committee was the only one to also examine the conditions of Jews in Europe.



This katzida recounts Hitler's conquests and domination over Europe and North Africa, the Nazi plot to annihilate the Jews, their defeat in North African territories, and the return of the Jews to Palestine. The katsida was published with the approval of the regional censorship authority (Visa fait par le Service du Contrôle Régional des Informations).

The opening is in Hebrew and follows the poetic form of Mi Khamokha hymns, as they developed in their North African expression. The remainder of the text is in Judeo-Moroccan Arabic and is written in the style of the traditional Moroccan

katsida. As is known, the Mi Khamokha piyyutim composed by Jewish poets in North Africa were devotional poems recounting miraculous events experienced by their communities. Most followed the model of Rabbi Yehuda Halevi, who recounted the miracle of Purim in his hymn for Shabbat Zakhor. There seem to be slight variants of it.
