



**1. O'CONNOR, R N - PALESTINE GOVERNMENT CURFEW
ORDER JERUSALEM 1938 - IN ENGLISH, ARABIC AND HEBREW.**

In Virtue of the powers vested in me by the Defence (Military Commanders) Regulations, 1938. I Major-General Richard Nugent O'Connor, Military Commander of the Jerusalem District, do hereby order all persons within the area of Jerusalem District described hereunder to remain within doors between the hours specified below as from the date of this order until further notice.

1. Town Planning area of Jerusalem from 11pm to 5am
2. Within the Old City of Jerusalem from 7pm to 5am

When it has been possible to re-establish the street lights, which have been destroyed by evilly disposed persons, I shall consider lifting the hours of Curfew to conform with those outside the Walls.

I warn the inhabitants that if there is any recrudescence of murder or shooting shall immediately impose Curfew again and take further measures to maintain public security.

I trust that with the good sense of the inhabitants it may be possible to remove all restrictions, but my decision depends on upon their behaviour.

הברזה על הקמת מדינת ישראל

בארץ-ישראל קם העם היהודי. בה עיצבה דמותו הרוחנית הדתית והמדינית. בה חי חיי קיומיות ממלכתית, בה יצר נכסי תרבות לאומיים וכלכליים וחורש לעולם כולו את ספר הספרים הנצחי.

לאחר שהוגלה העם מארצו בנות הודוע שמר לה אמונים בכל ארצות פזורה, ולא חדל מתפלה ומתקוה לשוב לארצו ולהחדש בתוכה את חירותו המדינית.

מתוך קשר היסטורי ומסורתי זה התרו היהודים בכל דור לשוב ולהאחז במולדתם העתיקה ובדורות האחרונים שבו לארצם בהמונים וחלוצים, מעפילים ומגנים הפריחו נשמות, הדיו שפתם העברית, בנו בפרים יערים והקימו ישוב גדל וחולך השלים על משקו ותרבותו, שוחר שלום ומנן על עצמו, מביא ברכת הקידמה לכל תושבי הארץ ונשוא נפשו לעצמאות ממלכתית.

בשנת תרנ"ז (1897) נתבנם הקונגרס הציוני לקול קריאתו של חוגה חוג המדינה היהודית תיאודור הרצל והכריז על זכות העם היהודי לתקומה לאומית בארצו.

זכות זו הוכרה בהצהרת בלפור מיום כ' בנובמבר 1917 ואשררה במנדט ממעם הבר הלאומים, אשר נתן במיוחד תוקף בינלאומי לקשר ההיסטורי שבין העם היהודי לבין ארץ-ישראל ולזכות העם היהודי להקים מחדש את ביתו הלאומי.

השואת שנתחוללה על עם ישראל בוסן האחרון, בה הוכרעו למבחן מיליונים יהודים באירופה, הוכיחה מחדש כעליל את ההכרה בפתרון בעית העם היהודי מחוסר המולדת והעצמאות על ידי חידוש המדינה היהודית בארץ-ישראל, אשר הפתח לרווחה את שערי המולדת לכל יהודי ותעניק לעם היהודי מעמד של אומה שווה זכויות בתוך משפחת העמים.

שארית הפליטה שניצלה מהמבח הנאצי האיום באירופה ויהודי ארצות אחרות לא חדלו להעפיל לארץ-ישראל, על אף כל קושי, מניעה ומכנה, ולא פסקו לתבוע את זכותם לחיי כבוד, חירות ועמלי-ישרים במולדת עמם.

במלחמת העולם השנייה תרם הישוב העברי בארץ את מלוא-הקול לסמך האומות השוכחות חירות ושלום נגד כוחות הרשע הנאצי, ובדם חייליו וכסאמטו המלחמתי קנה לו את הזכות להמנות עם העמים מייסדי ברית האומות המאוחדות. כיצד בנובמבר 1947 קיבלה עצרת האומות המאוחדות החלטה המחייבת הקמת מדינה יהודית בארץ-ישראל, העצרת תבעה מאת תושבי ארץ-ישראל לאחוז בעצמם בכל הצעדים הנדרשים מצדם הם לביצוע ההחלטה. הכרה זו של האומות המאוחדות בזכות העם היהודי להקים את מדינתו אינה ניתנת להפקעה.

זוהי זכותו הטבעית של העם היהודי להיות ככל עם ועם עומד ברשות עצמו במדינתו הריבונית.

לפיכך נתכנסנו, אנו חברי מועצת העם, נציגי הישוב העברי והתנועה הציונית, ביום סיום המנדט הבריטי על ארץ-ישראל, ובתוספת זכותנו הטבעית וההיסטורית ועל יסוד ההלטה עצרת האומות המאוחדות אנו מכריזים בואת על הקמת מדינה יהודית בארץ-ישראל, היא מדינת ישראל.

It also contains the annulment of the infamous 1939 White Paper restricting Jewish immigration to Palestine. אחינו בני-ישראל היקרים - תתברכו בשנת גאולה וישועה!

בתחדש השנה אנו קוראים כולנו, כיחיד וכצבור, לחשבון הנפש ולחשוב הדרך. ישמחו נא לנו ימים נוראים אלה להרהורי תשובה ולהתעוררות למעשים טובים וישרים. -עבר קציר כלה קיץ ואנחנו לא נישענו. חלפה שנת-שלום נוספת וטרם חל שינוי לטובה במצבו האיום של עמנו. ראשי האומות המנצחות התכנסו לדון על טרל העולם ועתידו. על גבולות השלטון ההשפעה - אך מקומו של ישראל, הקרבן הראשי של מבול הדמים נפקד בתוכם. והדי אסונו הכבד לא חדרו מבצר ללבבות הקשוחים, עומדים אחינו ואחיותנו.

עדיין עומדים אחינו ואחיותנו, שארית הפליטה, על חורבות קהילותינו המפוארות באירופה ועל קברי האבות והבנים. רבבות עודם כלואים במחנות-הסגר ללא חופש תנועה. אכולי יאוש וחדורי פחד-אימים. נרדפים הם לעינינו, מגבול לגבול ע"י ירשי הנאצים, העורכים בהם טבח ופוגרומים - ומצפון העולם לא נתעורר. שותקים שליטי העולם ומתעלמים מסבלנו כשם שהתעלמו מיסורינו עת נשרפו קרבנותינו במשרפות אושוויץ ומאידניק. ערלים לבבות הגויים ואטומות אזניהם.

ובשעה - זו שערי המולדת נעולים על מסגר. הבנים השבים אליה בחשאי, באניות-ההעפלה הרעועות, מרוחקים מחופיה ביד קשה ואכזרית. העם שהופקד לעזור ולסייע בהקמת ביתנו הלאומי מעל בשליחותו והפך לראש המפריעים; מדכא בכוח השריון את תנועת הגאולה ומתנקש בראש מאוייה: להציל את שרידי העם הנדחים ולבנות להם בית ומקלט בארצם. במליצורת האהדה וההשתתפות מנסים לכסות על הקשיחות והרשעות.

בגאון לאומי דחה הישוב חלון האומה את התקפת גייסות הכובשים על מרכז השחרור של העם העברי בארצו. בזקני ובצעיריו הוא נכון לכל מאבק והיה קרבנותיו אשר יהיו, לשם מילוי תפקידו בימי הכרעה המאים לקראתנו. גבורת ישראל האמיתית מווקעת הסבל והיסורים קמה לתחייה. בלכודנו הפנימי המלא ובאחדות כוחותינו נעמוד בעזרת ה' במערכה על עצמאות האומה, נעמוד ונצליח. נגרש מתוכנו את השטן המרקד בפנים המחנה ונציל את הישוב ממריבות אחים נתאחד ונתלכד תחת מרות לאומית עליונה. שמירתה האחת: גאולה ישראל בארצו.

ובימים של חסון הנפש לאומה הגנו פגמים בקריאה: ישבו בנים אל אבותם ויחזרו אוים תועים לחוק התורה ולקיום מצוותיה המעשיות. יעלה הנוער העברי על הדרך המצויה בין העבר והעתיד וממלא את השמירה על קניני הדורות עם המאבק המעשי על השחרור והפדיון מיישובי עמק בית-שאן, סובשי טירת-צבי, ח'לוצי סדה-יעקב, מעפילי סדה-עציון, אסירי בריה, תלמידי ישיבת בני-יעקב ואלפי המועלים הרחיים בעיר ובכפר שעמדו במבחן, התוו את הדרך גם לאחרים. תלכידי היהדות הנאמנה לכל שכבותיה טסביב להפועל הדיוי היוצר והמנשים את חונו להשילטת התורה בחיי הארץ הכבנית. כימי תשובה ותפלה אלה נבטה בעור ישראל וגאולו, כי ישלח לנו ישועתו מברום - וכל הרשעה כלה. כעשן תבלה כי תביר ממשלת דין מן הארץ.

THE ARABS INSIST ON THEIR RIGHTS

The Balfour Declaration was a unilateral document, not binding on the Arabs either morally or legally.

The British Government never intended this Declaration as a charter for converting Palestine into a Jewish State. Officially this was made clear in the British White Paper of 1922 and again in the White Paper of 1939. In the latter it is specifically stated:

"His Majesty's Government therefore now declares unequivocally that it is not part of their policy that Palestine should become a Jewish State. They would indeed regard it as contrary to their obligations to the Arabs under the Mandate, as well as to the assurances which have been given to the Arab people in the past, that the Arab population of Palestine should be made the subjects of a Jewish State against their will." (Cmd 6019, p. 4.)

While many official promises have been made to the Arabs by the British Government, Arab rights do not rest on any such political promises or declarations.

The Arab claim to Palestine rests on these simple facts: (a) large Arab majority, (b) formerly uninterrupted possession for 13 centuries, (c) unity in traditions, culture and language. It is the inherent right of any people so domiciled in a land to maintain jealously its hold on that land.

Before the first World War there were ten Arabs to one Jew. But today there are ten Arabs to four Jews.

Zionists at present are bent on converting the Arab majority in Palestine into a minority. They are denying Palestine democratic government until such Jewish majority is attained. If we accede to the demand for the immediate admission

of 100,000 Jewish refugees into Palestine, it will not be long before the Jews become a majority there.

For centuries Arabs and Jews have lived in peace and harmony in Muslim and Arab lands. It is in the interest of all Jews who are already in Palestine and everywhere in the Muslim world that everything should be done to allay the suspicions, the fears and resentment of the Arabs.

Palestine is regarded by all Arabs as an integral and inseparable part of the Arab world.

If the Zionists insist on pursuing their program to its logical but perilous conclusion their act will arouse intense and bitter opposition among all Arabs—Muslims and Christians—and will create a bloc of 60,000,000 Arabs and 300,000,000 Muslims against the Jews.

Zionism is neither a humanitarian nor a religious program. It is a political program. The Jewish problem is a European problem. The refugee problem is also a European problem. Neither of these problems has been created by the Arabs. The Arabs of Palestine should not be held alone responsible for the solution. It does not lie in the artificial establishment of a Jewish state in Palestine, but in the assurance of true democracy and the guarantee of security throughout the world.

We ask you Americans:

1. Would you want to give the so-called homeless and stateless Jews a sovereign homeland within your borders?

2. Would you tolerate constant outside interference and dictation in your internal affairs?

3. Would you permit foreign governments to control your immigration policy?

ZIONIST CLAIMS AND ARAB REFUTATIONS

1. Zionists rest their claim to Palestine on historical grounds.

1. So do the Arabs. The fact is that the Arabs have been there for centuries and are there now. Jews left Palestine in 70 A. D.

2. Zionists claim Palestine as religious grounds.

2. So do 300,000,000 Muslims, to whom it is the second holiest land.

3. Zionists claim that the Arabs cannot be entrusted with the rights of minorities.

3. When Christianity was persecuting Jews, the Arabs tolerated them and gave them refuge. Christian Arabs are one with their Muslim brethren in opposing Zionism.

4. Zionists claim that the Arabs cannot be entrusted with the protection of the Holy Places.

4. A Muslim family, the Nussabehs of Jerusalem, have been entrusted by the Christians with the custody of the keys of the Holy Sepulchre for several generations.

5. Zionists claim that since Palestine constitutes less than one per cent of the Arab world, the Arabs should concede this "match" to their Jewish cousins.

5. Most of the Arab world consists of deserts. The state of Vermont is less than one per cent of the area of the United States. Would the people of Vermont be willing to concede it and move into other parts of the United States upon an order from a foreign power or group of powers?

6. Zionists claim that the Arabs benefit from their colonization of Palestine.

6. With reference to Jewish colonization of Arab land, Sir John Hope Simpson, in his report (Cmd. 3880), said: "It seems to be land from which the Arab can gain any advantage whether now or at any other time in the future. He is deprived forever from employment on that land. Nor can anyone help him by purchasing the land and reselling it to someone else. The land is in southern and unalienable."

7. Zionists claim they brought the benefits of Western civilization to the Arabs of Palestine.

7. Syria, Lebanon, Egypt, Iraq and Turkey have prospered and made remarkable progress without benefit of Zionist immigration. In the last 40 years the population of Egypt has tripled.

The Arabs have not benefited at all from Jewish immigration because the majority of the Jewish immigrants are not educated. As to medical facilities, Arabs do not frequent the hospitals. According to the last report of the Palestine Government to the League of Nations, out of 11,800 patients admitted to Zionist hospitals, 4 were Muslims, 1 was Christian, and 11,795 were Jews.

8. Zionists claim that with intensive industrialization a large Jewish population is possible in Palestine.

8. According to Mr. Paulson of the Bankers Trust, Jewish enterprises in Palestine are only 40 per cent self-supporting. Thus far, Zionist intensive industrialization in Palestine has been possible only through charity and discriminatory tariffs.

1. "The Turkish portions of the present Ottoman Empire should be assured sovereignty, but the other nationalities which are now under Turkish rule should be assured an undoubted security of life and an absolutely unmolested opportunity of autonomous development."

From President Wilson's Fourteen Points.

2. "Your Majesty will also doubtless recall that during our recent conversation I assured you that I would take no action in my capacity as Chief of the Executive Branch of this Government, which might prove hostile to the Arab people."

President Franklin Delano Roosevelt—in his letter to King Ibn Saud, April 3, 1945.

3. "We believe that all peoples who are prepared for self-government should be permitted to choose their own form of government by their own freely expressed choice, without interference from any foreign source. That is true in Europe, in Asia, in Africa, as well as in the Western Hemisphere."

President Harry Truman—in his speech on Navy Day, October 27, 1945.

The causes of the riots and the situation in Palestine had been investigated by the Shaw Commission. An inquiry into land settlement, immigration, and development had been carried out by Sir John Hope Simpson, (see; Cmd. 3687 Hope-Simpson report) who was pessimistic as to the possibilities of further Jewish immigration and settlement without displacing Arabs. It rejected the view that the passages regarding the Jewish National Home were the principal feature of the Mandate. Passfield called for a renewed attempt at establishing the Legislative Council, and supported the Hope-Simpson findings on land availability and cultivation. On the critical question of immigration, the sentiments of the paper were against a generous policy towards the Zionists. The Zionist movement mounted a major campaign against the White Paper and in a letter made public, during February 1931, British Prime Minister, Ramsay MacDonald, promised Chaim Weizmann what amounted to its abrogation. 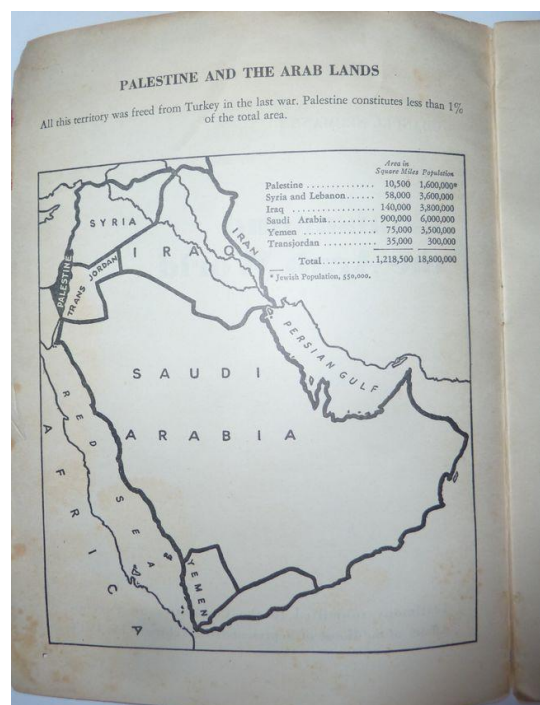
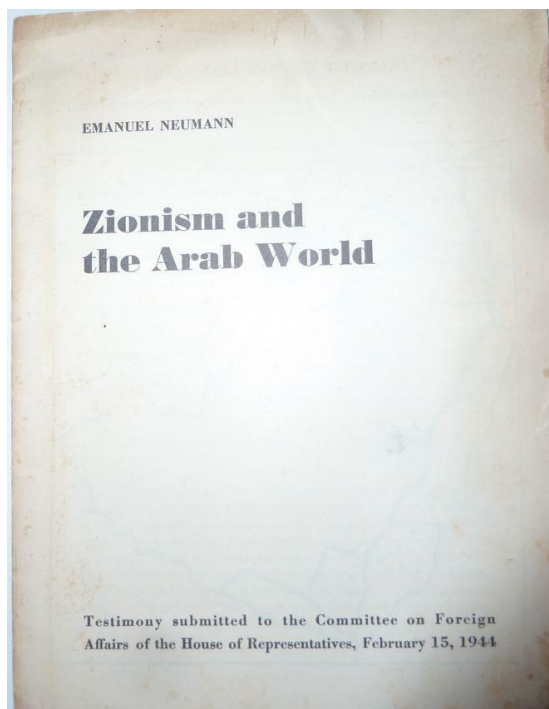
