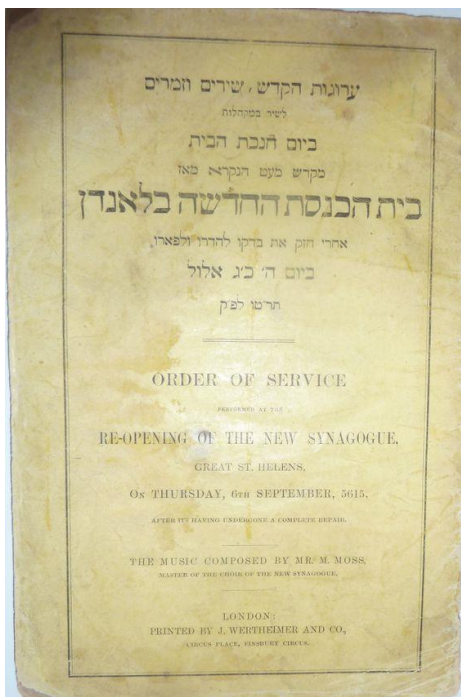

Photos are 22.5 x 17 cm (landscape) or 17 x 22.5cm (portrait) Photos taken at the liberation of the camps. Some are captioned in French and

most identify the camp where the photograph was taken. Some are captioned in French. The camps include Buchenwald, Dachau, Ohrdruf, Penig, Nordhausen and Belsen. The photographs include pictures of the concentration camps inmates, bodies of those who did not survive, barbed wire around the camps and US and British soldiers assisting survivors. One of the photographs shows the liberation of General Audibert with a group of other inmates. General Audibert was a French General who fought with the Resistance and was captured by the Gestapo and was liberated from Buchenwald by the Americans. Includes a photo of Frau Koch, the particularly cruel wife of the Buchenwald Kommandant. Frau Koch ordered tattooed prisoners to be killed and removed the skin with their tattoos and made the skin into objects such as purses or lampshades. It was established by Stalin in 1928 in the remote Russian Far East region, as a means to promote increased settlement in the area and shore up the border region with China. At the same time it was to generate good will with the country's Jewish population, who had in recent years faced

discrimination and violence at the hand of local and Soviet authorities.

The United Nations Relief and Rehabilitation Administration (UNRRA) was established by agreement of 44 nations on 9 November 1943; operations came to an end in the latter part of 1946, with the last staff appointment terminating 31 March 1949. The purpose of UNRRA was to "plan, coordinate, administer or arrange for the administration of measures for the relief of

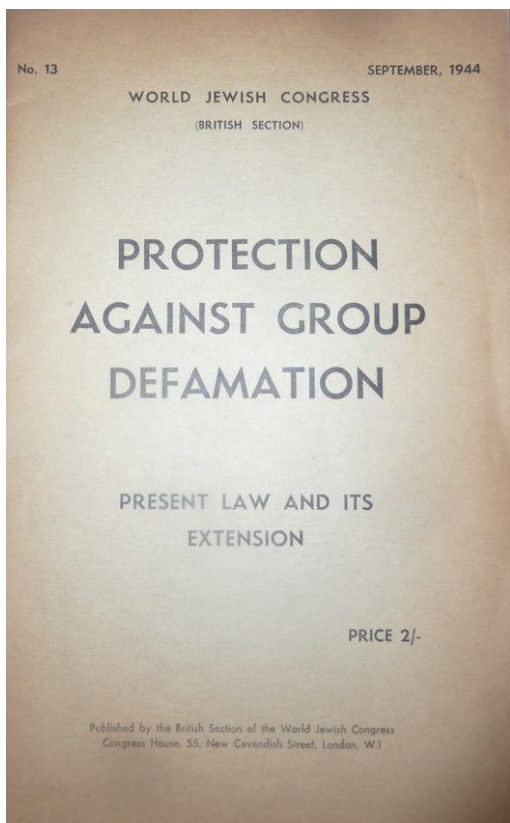
victims of war in any area under the control of any of the United Nations through the provision of food, fuel, clothing, shelter and other basic necessities, medical and other essential services."

Although initially restricted by its constitution to render aid only to nationals from the United Nations (the Allies), this was changed late in 1944, in response to pleas from Jewish organizations who were concerned with the fate of surviving Jews of German nationality, to also include "other persons who have been obliged to leave their country or place of origin or former residence or who have been deported therefrom by action of the enemy because of race, religion or activities' in favor of the United Nations." Although UNRRA operated in occupied Germany, primarily operating Displaced Persons camps, the organization did not render assistance to ethnic Germans.

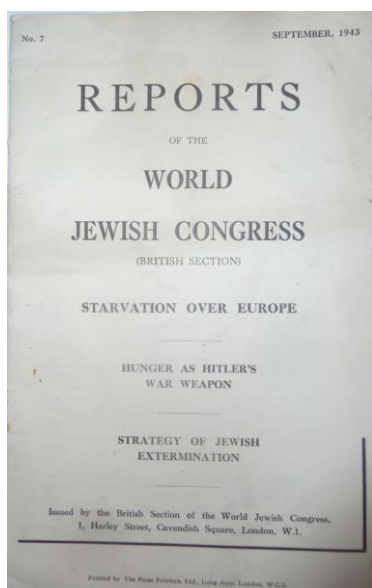
Interestingly, UNRRA of course pre-dated the UN by some time. The use of 'United Nations' in its name is due to Roosevelt's coining of the term in 1942 - used for UNRRA, and then later for the UN itself.

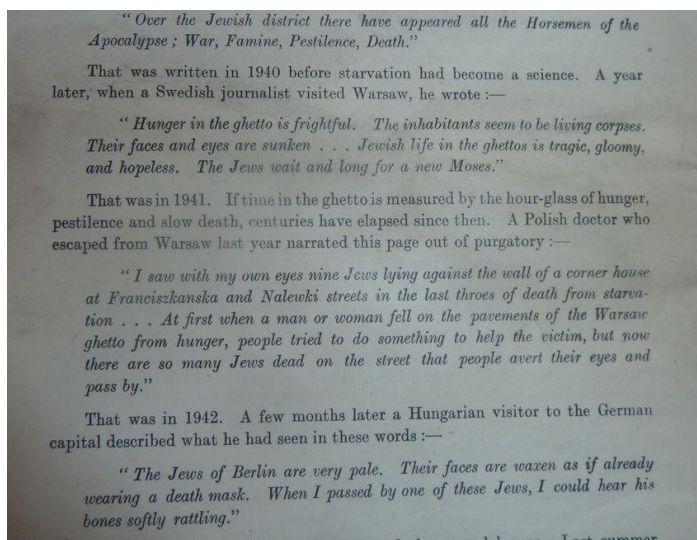

In Oslo six of the largest restaurants have been taken over and provisioned with ample supplies to serve the choicest foods - to Germans only. The city's largest grocery establishment, Jensen and Company, has a separate counter where Germans only may buy milk, butter, cheese and eggs. Quisling-run restaurants in Bergen offer roast beef and chicken to their German customers, while Norwegians are lucky to get whale meat."

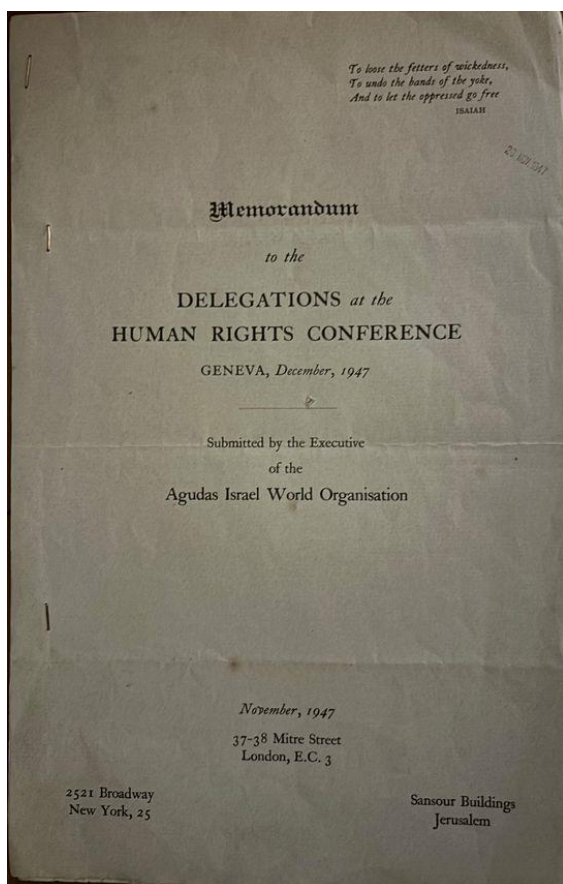

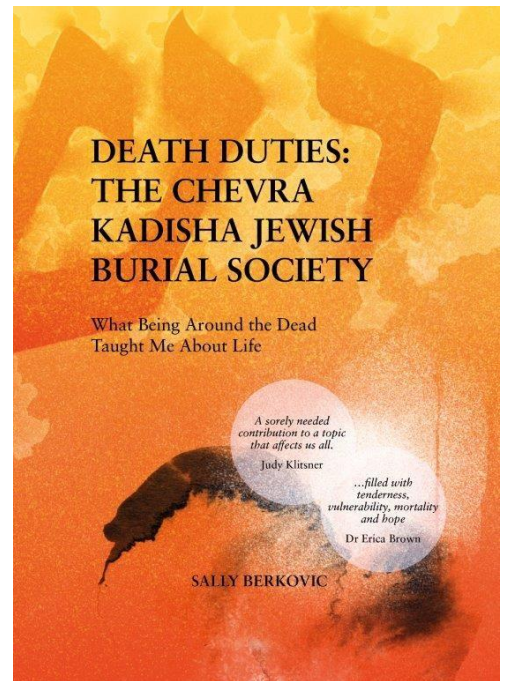
