1. HAPPY NEW YEAR: L'SHANA TOVA TIKATEVU V'TICHATAMO - :V-MAIL FROM WORLD WAR II HAPPY NEW YEAR 5706 - 1945-6

Happy New Year - Rosh Hashanah V-Mail from World War II. Used by US Forces in Italy. This is US Army one sent from someone in the Polish Forces of the C.M.F. (Central Mediterranean Forces, British and Allied) to Mandatory Palestine.

To ease the burden on the postal system, V-mail was introduced during World War II for correspondence with service members stationed abroad. Stationery was photographed and transported on microfilm and then reproduced on small paper sheets at the destination. It was the primary way for soldiers and their families at home to communicate during the war, and this included Shana Tova cards, some of which were made from templates provided by Jewish chaplains. They illustrate the importance of the holidays and friends and family to the morale of these men and women. 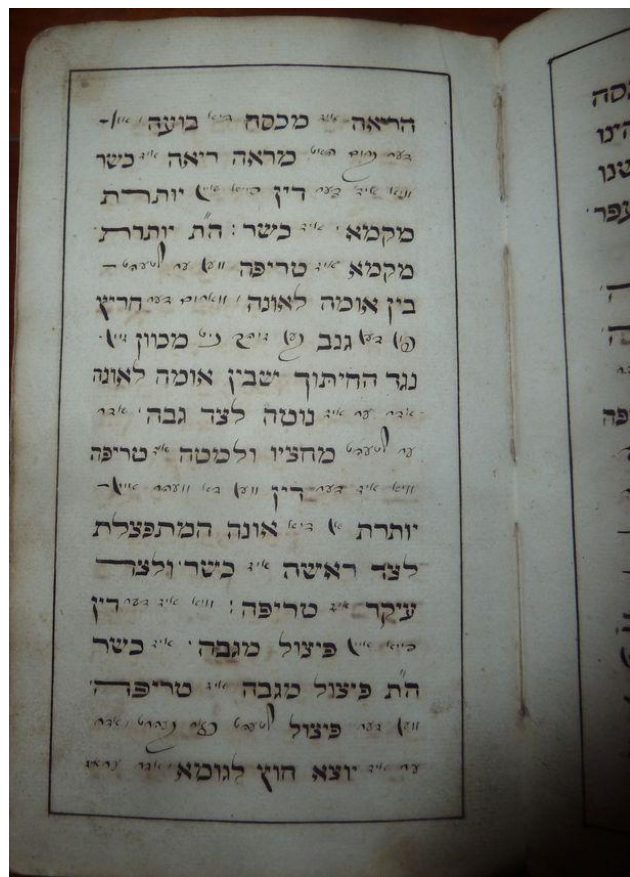

This Eruv permits the transportation of personal objects on the Sabbath on the Lower East Side of New York. This pamphlet engendered great controversy as to whether such an Eruv as proposed, utilizing the rivers and the "El," was valid or not. Consequently, the author includes here responsa of a number of European rabbis supporting his position (viz. R. Shalom Mordecai Hakohen of Brezan, Aryeh Leibush Halevi Hurwitz of Stanislav and Moses Nahum Jerusalemiski of Kielce). The pamphlet was published in two stages: Pages 1-26 were published first and sent to various rabbis for their opinion. 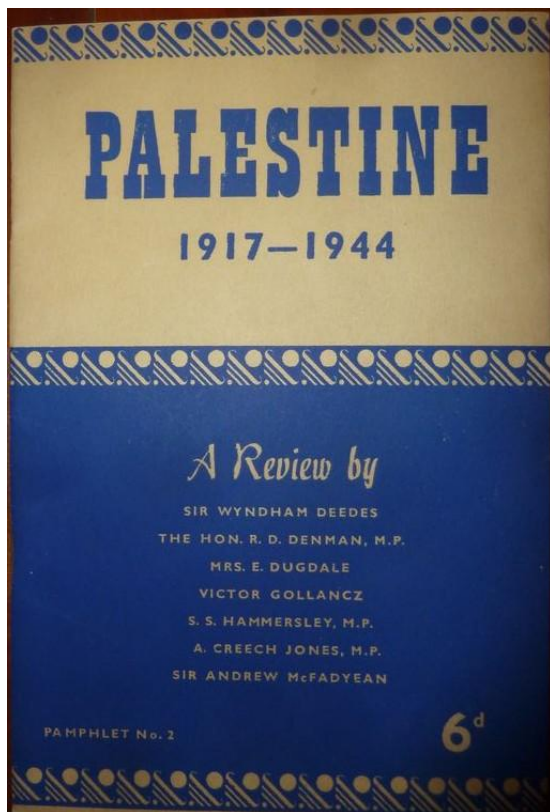
Full transcript of the statement by Israeli Prime Minister David Ben-Gurion regarding UN involvement in Middle Eastern affairs following the Sinai War. In his speech, Ben-Gurion criticizes the United Nations for its failure to demand that the Arab states, Egypt,

Lebanon, Jordan, and Syria, uphold the Armistice Agreements they had signed in 1949, despite repeated violations.

"The situation in the Gaza Strip is unique... The entry of a UN force into the Strip will lead to a deterioration in the security situation..."

"The Gaza Strip, which was never Egyptian territory and was occupied by the Egyptian invaders in 1948 in violation of international law, served over the years as a springboard for aggression against Israel. Most of the gangs of murderers and terrorists were sent from the Strip... From the Gaza Strip, Fedayeen units were dispatched into Israel, and gangs of murderers and saboteurs were also organized in other Arab countries..."

Jewish traffickers would lure Jewish women from Eastern Europe under the guise of marrying them or promising them jobs in London or other major cities. The traffickers would often meet vulnerable women when they arrived at the ports. To counter this, the Jewish Association for the Protection of Girls and Women was founded in 1885 by Constance Flower [Rothschild, Baroness Battersea] and Claude Montefiore. They sent agents to the docks to protect vulnerable women and girls from the traffickers and held several conferences in London which had the support of Chief Rabbis Adler and Hertz as this sermon demonstrates. Timayenis, a Greek academic, established Minerva Publishing House as the first Anti-Semitic publishing house in America. This was his first book at Minerva. Singerman writes, "Presents a colorful account of Jewish exploitation, criminality, usury, lechery, vulgarity, and fraud in the immigrant ghetto of New York City. The Christian-hating Jews are depicted as parasites, competing with the Anglo-Saxons for control of America. "

"The work, published in 1888, embodied anti-Semitism in its most base, rabid form: a vile portrait of dirty, deceitful, hook-nosed Hebrews swindling unwary gentiles and causing most of the world's evils."

Timayenis was one of the first to "formulate a discourse on the Jewish Question along racial lines in the United States, rather than considerations of religious doctrine." [ref: 23703]

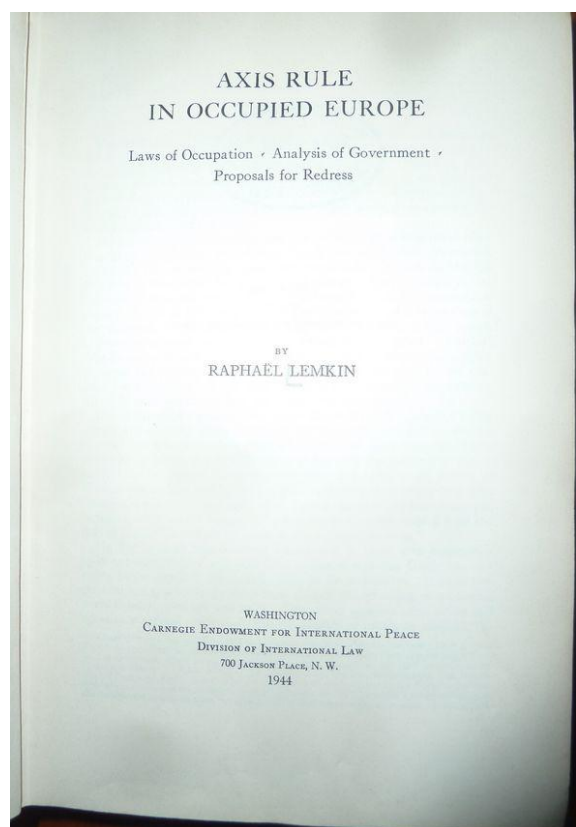
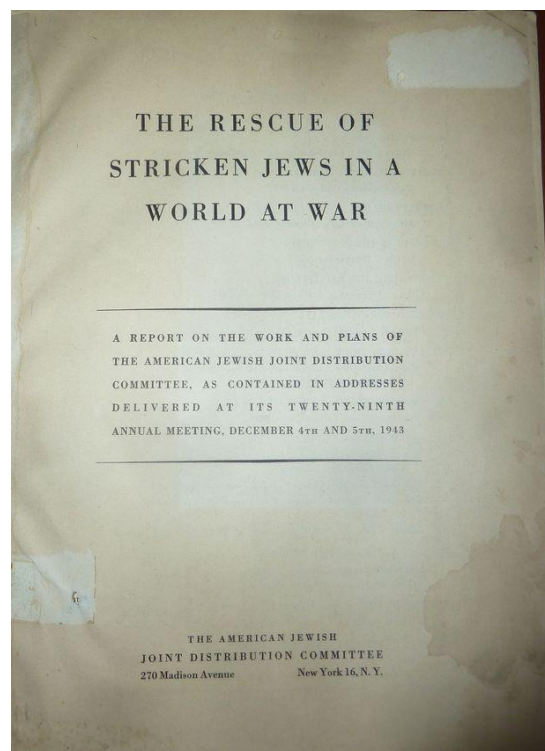

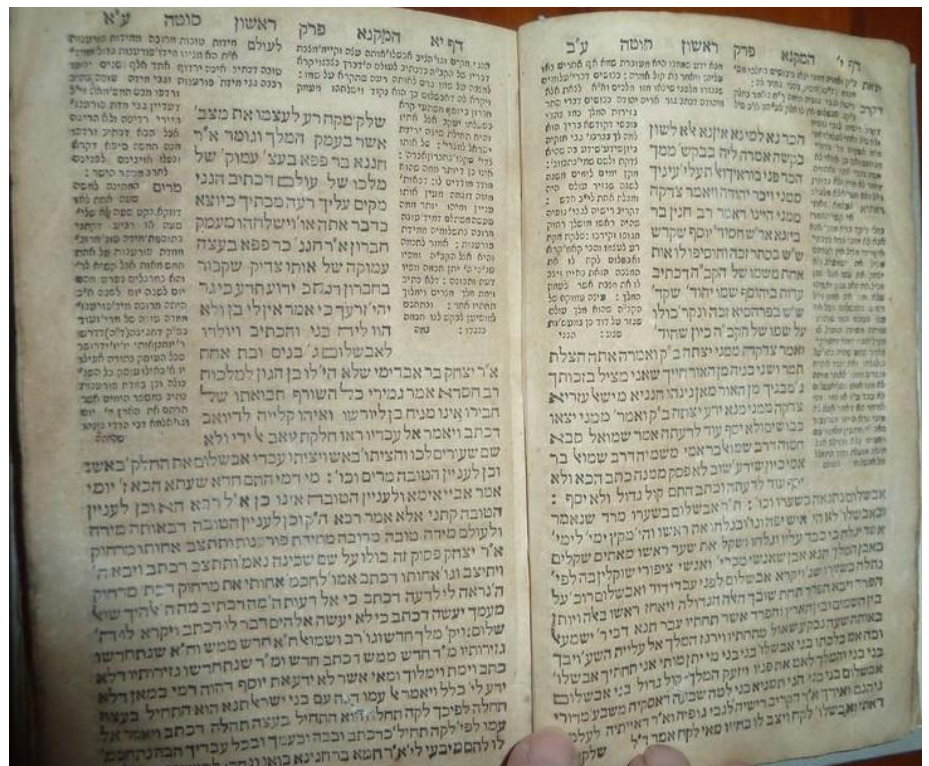
